BY THE NUMBERS

Philadelphia has won 7 of its last 10 games (.700) vs. Detroit (including playoffs). Overall, the Eagles are 17-15-2 (.529) in the all-time series against the Lions.

Nelson Agholor posted a season-high 8 receptions for 107 yards (13.4 avg.) and 1 TD in Week 2 at Atlanta (3rd career game with 100+ yards).

Cameron Johnston leads the NFL in net punting average (48.6) and ranks 2nd in gross average (51.9). Through 2 games, he has 5 punts of 50+ yards.

Philadelphia's defense has allowed the 3rd-fewest rushing yards per game (42.5) in the NFL in 2019, behind Baltimore (20.5) and New England (37.0).

The Eagles own the 6th-highest scoring offense (25.6) in the NFL since 2017 (including playoffs), trailing only L.A. Rams (29.8) and New Orleans (28.7) in the NFC.

Philadelphia picked off Falcons QB Matt Ryan 3 times in Week 2 at Atlanta, marking the team's first game with 3+ INTs since 11/19/17 at Dallas.

HOME, SWEET HOME

Including playoffs, Philadelphia has recorded the 2nd-best home winning percentage (.778, 21-6) in the NFL since 2016, trailing only New England (.867, 26-4).

- Doug Pederson has led the Eagles to a 34-21 record since 2016 (including playoffs), which marks the highest winning percentage (.618) by a head coach in franchise history. Pederson's .778 home winning percentage is also the best in team history.
- Philadelphia has won 8 of its last 11 contests (.727) at Lincoln Financial Field (including playoffs), in addition to 17 of its last 21 home games (.810) overall.
