NOTES TO KNOW

BIRDS ON PRIMETIME

- Philadelphia has produced the 5th-best primetime winning percentage (.706, 12-5) in the NFL since 2016 (including playoffs), behind New England (.773), Seattle (.767), Pittsburgh (.733) and Dallas (.722).



UNDEFEATED TEAMS ON THURSDAY NIGHT FOOTBALL (SINCE 2016)

- The Eagles are one of only four NFL teams who have posted an undefeated record (3-0) on Thursday Night Football since 2016, joining L.A. Chargers, Pittsburgh and Seattle. (Philadelphia also won its Thursday night season opener vs. Atlanta in 2018.)



MONEY DOWN

- Philadelphia ranks 2nd in the NFL in third-down offense (56.3%), behind Dallas (58.1%).
- Carson Wentz has completed 25-of-36 (69.4%) third-down attempts for 343 yards, 5 TDs, 1 INT and a 127.7 passer rating.
- Wentz's 127.7 third-down passer rating is the 5th-highest mark in the NFL, trailing only Lamar Jackson (147.5), Russell Wilson (135.1), Patrick Mahomes (132.9) and Derek Carr (130.6) (min. 20 attempts).

BY THE NUMBERS

.607

Doug Pederson has led the Eagles to a 34-22 record since 2016 (including playoffs), the highest winning percentage (.607) by a head coach in team history.

50.7

Cameron Johnston ranks 2nd in the NFL in gross punting average (50.7), behind Tress Way (51.8). He has totaled 7 punts of 50+ yards in 2019.

25.6

Philadelphia owns the 6th-highest scoring offense (25.6) since 2017 (including playoffs), trailing only L.A. Rams (29.6) and New Orleans (28.8) in the NFC.

18&3

Nelson Agholor is just the 2nd player in Eagles history to produce 18+ receptions and 3+ TDs through 3 games, joining Terrell Owens in 2004 and 2005.

5-5

Philadelphia has posted a 5-5 record in its last 10 regular-season games vs. Green Bay (last win against Packers: W, 27-13 on 11/10/13 at Lambeau Field).

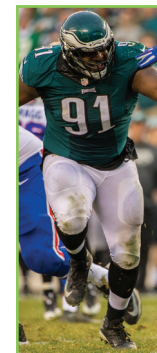
2.95

The Eagles have limited opponents to just 2.95 yards per rushing attempt, which ranks 2nd among NFL defenses, behind New England (2.29).
