CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Led the Eagles with team postseason records in receiving yards (219) and receiving TDs (3) during their **Super Bowl LII**-winning playoff run in 2017. Caught the first TD of **Super Bowl LII** (2/4/18 at NE), a 34-yard pass from QB **Nick Foles** that gave Philadelphia a 9-3 lead in the first quarter
- Earned his first **Pro Bowl** honor and was named PFWA's Most Improved Player after producing career highs in receptions (89) and receiving yards (1,421) with Chicago in 2013

NOTES TO KNOW

- Has produced the 5th-most red zone receiving TDs (17) in the NFL since 2017, trailing only **Davante Adams** (22), **Zach Ertz** (20), **Michael Thomas** (20) and **DeAndre Hopkins** (19)

2019 SEASON - EAGLES

- Finished the season leading all Eagles WRs in receptions (43), receiving yards (490) and receiving TDs (4)
- Posted 5 receptions for 49 yards and 1 TD and added his first career rushing TD in the 32-27 win vs. Was. (9/18/19). Became the first Eagles WR to record a receiving TD and rushing TD in the same game since **DeSean Jackson** on 10/17/10 at Atlanta

2018 SEASON - EAGLES

- Led all Eagles WRs in receptions (65), receiving yards (843) and receiving TDs (6) and produced a career-high catch rate (70.7%), despite missing the first 3 games of the season
- Recorded 8 catches for a season-high 160 yards (20.0 avg.) in the 30-23 win at LAR (12/16/18). His 160 receiving yards are his most as an Eagle and the 3rd-most of his career overall

2017 SEASON - EAGLES

- Set team postseason records in receiving yards (219) and receiving TDs (3) during the Eagles' **Super Bowl LII**-winning playoff run
- Caught the first TD of **Super Bowl LII** (2/4/18 at NE), a 34-yard pass from QB **Nick Foles** that gave Philadelphia a 9-3 lead in the first quarter. Became the first Eagle with multiple 30+ yard TD catches in the same postseason since **Fred Barnett** in 1992
- Totaled 85 receiving yards and 2 TDs in the NFC Championship vs. Min. (1/21/18). Became just the fifth player in franchise history to record 2+ receiving TDs in a playoff game, joining **Brent Celek** (1/18/09 at Ari.), **Chad Lewis** (1/23/05 vs. Atl.), **Fred Barnett** (1/3/93 at NO) and **Harold Carmichael** (12/23/79 vs. Chi.)
- Produced a team-leading 9 receiving TDs in the regular season. Also ranked 2nd on the Eagles' offense in receiving yards (789), trailing only **Zach Ertz** (824)

2016 SEASON - BEARS

- Led the Bears in yards per reception (15.8) and receiving yards per game (68.4) (min. 40 receptions)

2015 SEASON - BEARS

- ▶ Tallied 54 catches for a team-high 807 yards and 4 TDs
- ▶ Registered 4 games with 100+ receiving yards: 107 yards on 12/13/15 vs. Washington, 151 yards on 11/9/15 at San Diego, 116 yards on 11/1/15 vs. Minnesota, 147 yards on 10/18/15 at Detroit. His 3 consecutive games with 100+ receiving yards tied for the longest streak in Bears history

2014 SEASON - BEARS

- ▶ Recorded his second consecutive season with 1,000+ receiving yards after leading the Bears with 1,133 yards and a career-high 10 TDs on 85 receptions (13.3 avg.)
- ▶ Caught TDs in 6 straight games from 11/16/14-12/14/14. Is one of three players in Chicago history to accomplish the feat

2013 SEASON - BEARS

- ▶ Earned his first **Pro Bowl** honor and was named PFWA's Most Improved Player after producing career highs in receptions (89) and receiving yards (1,421) with Chicago
- ▶ Became just the eighth player in NFL history to record multiple games with 200+ receiving yards (249 yards on 12/1/13 at Minnesota, 218 yards on 10/6/13 vs. New Orleans)

2012 SEASON - BEARS

- ▶ Posted 24 receptions for 367 yards and 3 TDs as a rookie

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Played in 39 career games at South Carolina (2009-11), finishing with 183 receptions (2nd in school history) for 3,042 yards (1st in school history and 2nd in SEC history) and 23 TDs (tied for 1st in school history)
- ▶ Named second-team All-SEC as a junior in 2011. Selected as a Biletnikoff Award finalist and unanimous first-team All-SEC honoree as a sophomore in 2010. Earned Freshman All-America and first-team SEC All-Freshman honors in 2009
