Aileen Dagrosa joined the Philadelphia Eagles in 2007 as director of legal affairs. She was named senior vice president, general counsel and administrative officer during the 2023 offseason. Prior to her current post, she served as senior vice president, general counsel since 2013 and as general counsel from 2010-13.

Dagrosa is responsible for overseeing legal and government affairs, human resources, league compliance, internal policies, and the team's DEI initiatives. She advises on legal aspects pertaining to both business and football operations and Lincoln Financial Field, including player transactions, compliance, sponsorship, licensing, event, media agreements, employment-related issues, disputes, risk management, government relations, and insurance.

In 2022, Dagrosa was honored as a Sports Business Journal Game Changer for her role in shaping the industry as a female sports executive.

Prior to joining the Eagles, Dagrosa worked as a corporate associate at Proskauer Rose LLP in New York. She participated in private equity buyouts, mergers, acquisitions, and sports financing acquisitions. Her clients included the Eagles, New York Jets, National Basketball Association, New Jersey Devils, Orlando Magic, Towers Perrin, and Veronis Suhler Stevenson.

Dagrosa is licensed to practice law in New York and in-house in Pennsylvania and is a member of the Sports Lawyers Association. She earned a B.A. in psychology from Yale University and a J.D. with a certificate in sports law from Tulane Law School.

She is on the Board of Advisors for the Jeffrey S. Moorad Center for the Study of Sports Law at Villanova University School of Law. Additionally, Dagrosa is a member of the Alumni Board of Advisors for the Tulane Law School Sports Law Program and is also on the Board of Directors for the Philadelphia Visitor Center Corporation. She previously served as president of the Yale Volleyball Association.
