

Ameena Soliman, who enters her sixth year with the Philadelphia Eagles, was elevated to director of personnel operations/pro scout in 2022.

Before earning her current role, Soliman spent the 2021 season working as a pro scout in the Eagles' scouting department. In addition, she served as a player personnel coordinator from 2019-20 after originally joining the organization as a player personnel intern during the 2018 campaign.
