Bryce Johnston, who enters his eighth year with the Philadelphia Eagles, was promoted to vice president of football transactions and strategic planning during the 2022 offseason.

In his current role, Johnston's responsibilities include the planning and execution of salary cap and resource allocation strategy, player acquisition and contract negotiation/structuring, and other aspects of roster transactions and Collective Bargaining Agreement compliance.

Johnston previously served as the senior director of football transactions (2021) after spending more than two years as the director of football administration (2019-21). He originally joined the team as a football administration intern during the 2016 offseason and was then elevated to a full-time role as a football administration coordinator in 2017.

Before entering the NFL, Johnston worked as a corporate associate at Proskauer Rose LLP (2014-16), where he focused on mergers and acquisitions and other transactional matters.

A native of Medford, NJ, Johnston graduated Summa Cum Laude from York College (PA) with a bachelor's degree in sport management in 2011. He was also a four-year member of the school's Division III men's lacrosse team. After graduating from York College, Johnston received a J.D. degree, Magna Cum Laude, from Georgetown University Law Center in 2014.
