BIRDSEED

- Is a skilled unicyclist who used to ride in parades throughout neighborhoods around Britton, SD ... Considers learning how to ride a six-foot unicycle at 12 years old as the greatest feat of his unicycling career
- Played nine-man football lining up as a WR, RB, and LB at Britton-Hecla (SD) High School due to the small population in his hometown
- Represented Feeding America’s Backpack Program through the NFL’s *My Cause My Cleats* initiative in 2024 ... The backpack program offers families free groceries for weekends and school breaks that include healthy, easy-to-prepare food for kid-friendly meals ... Has also supported the Wawa Foundation through MCMC, championing life-saving research and care for people in need, leading hunger relief efforts, and supporting the heroes making a difference in the community

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Is the Eagles’ all-time leader in postseason receptions (52)
- Paced the team in catches (17) and receiving yards (215) during Philadelphia’s **Super Bowl LIX**-winning playoff run ... Finished with the most receiving yards by a TE in a single postseason in franchise history
- Also led the Eagles with 16 receptions for 141 yards and 1 TD during the 2022 playoffs, earning a Super Bowl LVII berth ... Has been a part of six playoff teams during his first seven NFL seasons

NOTES TO KNOW

- Ranks 3rd among NFL TEs in YAC per reception (5.9) dating back to 2021, behind **Jonnu Smith** (6.4) and **George Kittle** (6.3) in that category (min. 200 catches)
- Has registered the 3rd-most receptions (409), 3rd-most receiving TDs (35) and 4th-most receiving yards (4,676) by a TE in franchise history

2025 SEASON - EAGLES

- Appeared in 15 contests (15 starts), registering a career-high 11 TDs on 60 receptions for 591 yards (9.9 avg.) ... Notched 2 TDs (1 rushing, 1 receiving) in the NFC Wild Card Playoff game vs. San Francisco (1/11/26)
- Notched a career-high-tying 2 scrimmage TDs, including a 1-yard rushing TD during the first quarter and a 9-yard TD reception during the second quarter versus San Francisco (1/11/26) ... Is just the sixth TE in NFL history to produce a rushing TD and receiving TD in the same game (only TE to do so in the playoffs)
- Set the Eagles TE record for single-season receiving TDs (11) on a 1-yard TD catch in the first quarter of the 13-12 win at Buffalo (12/28/25) ... Tied **A.J. Brown** (2022) for the 5th-most single-season receiving TDs (11) in team history, behind **Terrell Owens** in 2004 (14), **Mike Quick** in 1983 (13) and **Tommy McDonald** in 1960 (13) and 1961 (13)
- Tied **Pete Retzlaff** (1965) for the most single-season receiving TDs by a TE in franchise history (10) on a 15-yard receiving TD in the third quarter of the 29-18 win at Washington (12/20/25)

- ▶ Led the team with 70 receiving yards and a career-high-tying 2 TDs (third time this season) on 6 receptions (11.7 avg.) in the victory vs. Las Vegas (12/14/25) ... Became the fifth player in franchise history to reach 400+ career receptions, joining **Harold Carmichael** (589, 1971-83), **Zach Ertz** (579, 2013-21), **Pete Retzlaff** (452, 1956-66) and **Brian Westbrook** (426, 2002-09)
- ▶ Finished with 28 yards and a career-high-tying 2 receiving TDs (second time this season) on 3 receptions (9.3 avg.) in the win vs. N.Y. Giants (10/26/25) ... Joined **Travis Kelce** (2022) and **Rob Gronkowski** (2015) as the only NFL TEs to record 7+ receiving TDs in their first seven games played in a season
- ▶ Posted 4 receptions for 37 yards (9.3 avg.) and tied his career-high with 2 receiving TDs in the 31-25 win at Tampa Bay (9/28/25)

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ A two-time first-team FCS All-America selection (2016-17) and two-time FCS Walter Payton Award finalist (2016-17) at South Dakota State, where he finished with the 3rd-most catches (198), 4th-most receiving yards (2,988) and 5th-most receiving TDs (21) in school history
- ▶ Over his last two years with the Jackrabbits, led all FCS TEs in catches (164) and receiving yards (2,404) while ranking 2nd in TDs (18)
- ▶ As a senior in 2017, earned first-team All-MVFC honors after leading nationally-ranked South Dakota State with 72 receptions and 1,111 receiving yards ... Ranked 2nd on the team with 7 TDs
- ▶ Received all-conference honors as a junior in 2016 after setting a single-season school record with 92 catches ... His 1,293 receiving yards were the 5th-most in Jackrabbits history (most by a TE)
