CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Is a three-time **Pro Bowl** selection (2018, '19, '20), 2017 *Associated Press* first-team **All-Pro** honoree and **Super Bowl LII** champion ... Is tied for the 2nd-most Pro Bowls by an OT in franchise history, behind **Jason Peters** (seven) ... Is also one of only three Eagles OTs to earn three consecutive Pro Bowl nods, joining Peters (2013-16) and **Frank "Bucko" Kilroy** (1953-55)
- ▶ In 2019, was part of an OL that became the fourth unit in Eagles history to send three players to the Pro Bowl (also **Brandon Brooks** and **Jason Kelce**) ... Allowed only 1 sack in 773 offensive snaps and helped the team rank 3rd in red zone TD efficiency (66.7%) and 4th in third-down conversion rate (45.4%)
- ▶ Blocked for one of the most dominant OLs in the league during Philadelphia's **Super Bowl LII**-winning season in 2017 ... Contributed to just the fifth OL in Eagles history to feature multiple All-Pros (also Kelce, both first-team selections) ... Helped the Eagles lead the NFL in red zone offense (65.5%) and rank 3rd in rushing offense (132.2 ypg) and offensive points per game (26.3)
- ▶ Helped Philadelphia finish 3rd in points per game (29.6), 5th in total offense (396.8 ypg), 6th in passing offense (272.3 ypg) and 9th in rushing offense (124.5 ypg) while setting team records in points (474) and TDs (54) during the 2014 season ... Surrendered only 1 sack in 889 offensive snaps
- ▶ Started all 16 games as a rookie and paved the way for the NFL's leading rusher – **LeSean McCoy** (1,607 yards) – in 2013 ... Was a member of the league's 2nd-ranked offense (417.3 ypg), which also ranked 1st in rushing (160.4 ypg) and 4th in scoring (27.6) ... Became the first Eagles rookie OT to start in a season opener since **John Welbourn** in 1999

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ As a senior in 2012, started 11 games at LT and garnered third-team All-America honors from CBSSports.com and second-team All-Big 12 recognition from the league's coaches ... Anchored a Sooners offense that ranked 12th in the nation with 497.9 total yards per game and posted a team-best 123 knockdowns ... Led the conference with 19 TD-resulting blocks
- ▶ Started 12 games at RT as a junior in 2011, as Oklahoma ranked 10th nationally in scoring (39.5 ppg), 5th in offense (512.3 ypg), 5th in passing (349.4 ypg) and 7th in fewest sacks allowed (11)
- ▶ Began his sophomore season in 2010 as a TE before converting to the defensive line ... Redshirted in 2009 after transferring
- ▶ Appeared in nine games as a reserve QB at Kilgore College (TX) in 2008, completing 32-of-61 (52.5%) attempts for 510 yards, 3 TDs and 7 INTs, while adding 24 yards and 1 TD on 17 carries

BIRDSEED

- ▶ During quarantine amid the COVID-19 pandemic, launched his own podcast, "Outside the Lane," which streamed on Instagram Live and is archived on YouTube ... The project found success almost immediately and has featured a wide array of guests, including "Stone Cold" Steve Austin, Charles Barkley, Brett Favre, Bryce Harper, Bob Saget and Mike Trout, among others



- ▶ Majored in human relations at Oklahoma
- ▶ Began his collegiate career at Kilgore College (TX), where at 202 pounds he was the Rangers' QB in 2008 ... After transferring to Oklahoma as a TE in 2009, he redshirted for one year before playing TE and DE in 2010 ... Settled in as a RT in 2011 prior to transitioning to the left side of the OL in 2012
- ▶ Attended Groveton (TX) High School, where he played QB and S and was an all-region and all-state selection ... Also participated in baseball, basketball and track and field ... Placed 4th in the shot put at the state's track championships ... His graduating class had just 35 students (Groveton's population in 2010 was 1,057)
- ▶ Did not start playing football until the 7th grade, when he was a QB for his middle school team in Coldspring, TX
- ▶ Credits his mother, Ray Ann, for helping him get to where he is today ... Ray Ann has a degree in criminal justice and works as a social worker with death-row inmates at a prison in Riverside, TX ... Purchased his mother a new home in 2014
