- ▶ Earned All-America and All-Big Sky recognition as a junior in 2017 ... Contributed to Weber State's historic year that included a Big Sky title, a school-record 11 wins and two FCS playoff victories
- ▶ Named all-conference honorable mention following his sophomore campaign in 2016 ... Started all 12 games on the OL after making the transition from defense during spring practices
