BIRDSEED

- ▶ Lived with **Avonte Maddox** during the first four years of his NFL career ... The inseperable duo is famously known for their “big brother, little brother” relationship, which has been captured in Wawa commercials as well as Amazon/NFL Films’ 2019 season of *All or Nothing*
- ▶ Represented the Wawa Foundation through the league’s *My Cause My Cleats* campaign in 2022 ... The non-profit organization is committed to building communities by providing care for those in need, leading hunger relief efforts and supporting military members
- ▶ Is a skilled unicyclist who used to ride in parades throughout neighborhoods around Britton, SD ... Considers learning how to ride a six-foot unicycle at 12 years old as the greatest feat of his unicycling career
- ▶ Played nine-man football lining up as a WR, RB and LB at Britton-Hecla (SD) High School due to the small population of his hometown

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Has been a part of four playoff teams during his first five seasons in Philadelphia ... A major contributor to the Eagles’ postseason run that resulted in an appearance in Super Bowl LVII in 2022 ... Led the team with 16 receptions for 141 yards and 1 TD during the 2022 playoffs

NOTES TO KNOW

- ▶ Since taking over as the Eagles’ primary TE in 2021, ranks 5th among NFL TEs in receiving yards (1,942), behind **Travis Kelce** (3,060), **Mark Andrews** (2,729), **George Kittle** (2,234) and **T.J. Hockenson** (2,178) ... Also is ranked 3rd in yards per catch among TEs during this span (13.0) trailing **George Kittle** (13.5) and **Kyle Pitts** (13.7)
- ▶ Is producing the 3rd-most yards after catch (1,028) among TEs since 2021, behind **George Kittle** (1,072) and **Travis Kelce** (1,501) ... Overall, leads the NFL at his position in YAC per reception (6.9) (min. 100 catches)

2023 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Totaled 77 receiving yards and 1 TD on 5 catches (15.4 avg) in the win vs. Miami (10/22/23) ... Scored a 19-yard TD in the second quarter on a pass from **Jalen Hurts**
- ▶ Finished with 117 yards and 1 TD on 8 receptions (14.6 avg.) in the 23-14 victory at L.A. Rams (10/8/23) ... Became the first Eagles TE to record 115+ receiving yards and 1+ TD in a road game since **Keith Jackson** on 9/17/89 at Washington (126 yards, 3 TDs) ... Hauled in a career-long, 49-yard reception during the third quarter

2022 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Produced 702 yards and 3 TDs on 55 receptions (12.8 avg.) during the regular season ... Caught a team-high 16 passes for 141 yards and 1 TD during the playoffs as the Eagles advanced to Super Bowl LVII
- ▶ Led all league TEs in receiving average (12.8), catch rate (career-high 79.7%) and YAC per reception (career-high 7.6) while finishing 2nd in receiving yards per game (career-high 58.5), trailing only **Travis Kelce** (78.7) (min. 40 receptions) ... Despite missing five games due to injury during Weeks 11-15, still ranked 3rd among his position in YAC (420), 4th in receiving first downs (40) and 7th in receiving yards (702)

- ▶ Posted 8 catches for a season-high 100 yards and 1 TD in the win at Houston (11/3/22) ... Extended the Eagles' lead to double-digits in the fourth quarter following a 4-yard TD pass from **Jalen Hurts**

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ A two-time first-team FCS All-America selection (2016-17) and two-time FCS Walter Payton Award finalist (2016-17) at South Dakota State, where he finished with the 3rd-most catches (198), 4th-most receiving yards (2,988) and 5th-most receiving TDs (21) in school history
- ▶ Over his last two years with the Jackrabbits, led all FCS TEs in receptions (164) and receiving yards (2,404) while ranking 2nd in TDs (18)
- ▶ As a senior in 2017, earned first-team All-MVFC honors after leading nationally-ranked South Dakota State with 72 receptions and 1,111 receiving yards ... Ranked 2nd on the team with 7 TDs
- ▶ Received all-conference honors as a junior in 2016 after setting a school single-season record with 92 catches ... His 1,293 yards were the 5th-most in Jackrabbits history (most by a TE)
