### 2022 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Appeared in 12 games and played in a combined 92 snaps (37 on offense, 55 on special teams)

### 2021 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Played in 340 offensive snaps and started a career-high five games at LT ... Blocked for a unit that helped the team lead the league in rushing offense (159.7 avg.), rushing TDs (25) and explosive plays (163) ... The Eagles established single-season franchise marks in rushing yards (2,715), rushing TDs (tied) and third-down percentage (45.7%)

### 2019 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Saw action in 346 offensive snaps and appeared in all 16 games as a rookie ... Started three games at LT and one game at RT

### COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Appeared in 42 career games at Washington State, including starts at LT in each of his last 39 contests ... A two-time All-Pac-12 honoree
- ▶ Started all 13 games as a senior in 2018, when he allowed just 1 sack and 13 pressures in 722 pass-blocking snaps ... Received All-America honors as well as first-team All-Pac-12 recognition
- ▶ Named honorable mention All-Pac-12 as a junior in 2017 ... Also collected all-conference accolades from *Pro Football Focus* following his sophomore season in 2016

- ▶ Earned a degree in social science at Washington State
- ▶ Attended Woodinville (WA) High School, where he was named All-King County First Team in addition to being voted King County 4A Credit Division Offensive Lineman of the Year as a senior
