2020 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Played in 29 defensive snaps (3%) and 42 special teams snaps (10%) over three contests in his first career NFL action with the Eagles ... Registered 1 solo tackle (11/22/20 at Cleveland) as well as 1 special teams tackle (1/3/21 vs. Washington)

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ One of Central Michigan's all-time leaders in tackles (220), TFLs (45.5) and sacks (26.0) ... Named the Co-Defensive Player of the Year for Central Michigan following the 2016-17 seasons
- ▶ Received first-team All-MAC honors as a senior in 2017 after totaling 60 tackles (34 solo), 19.5 TFLs and 13.0 sacks (ranked 2nd in the nation, behind Illinois' **Sutton Smith** - 14.0)

BIRDSEED

- ▶ Before entering the NFL, worked at his family bakery, Mackinaw Bakery ... The bakery was his first job and it has been in his family for three generations, starting with his great grandfather
- ▶ While at Central Michigan, was awarded the 2017 Famous Idaho Potato Bowl Humanitarian Award and received 2016 MAC Academic Team and MAC Scholar Athlete of the Week honors
- ▶ Attended LaSalle (MI) High School, where he was a four-year letterwinner playing LB and TE ... Honored as both the Ski Valley Conference North Defensive and Conference Player of the Year ... Led the Saints to a conference championship and advanced to the state semifinals during his junior and senior campaigns
- ▶ Also wrestled in high school and was a three-time Michigan state champion ... Owns multiple school wrestling records, including consecutive wins (141) and wins in a season (57)
