### **CAREER HIGHLIGHTS**

- Saw time in 512 offensive snaps (46%) in 9 games, including eight starts at RG and one start at RT, during the 2021 season ... Helped pave the way for the top rushing team in the NFL (159.7 ypg) and ranked 4th in rushing yards per carry (4.94)
- Played in 11 games (four starts) and earned a combined 300 offensive snaps (27%) as a rookie in 2020 ... Blocked for a unit that ranked 3rd in rushing average (5.0) and 9th in rushing yards per game (126.7) ... Became the Eagles' first rookie OL to start in a season opener since Lane Johnson in 2013

#### **COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS**

- Saw action in 46 career games between Auburn (2018-19) and Massachusetts (2015-17) ... Started each of his last 45 contests, which marked the 10th-longest active streak by an FBS OL
- Started all 13 games in 2019 and was named to the preseason All-SEC second-team by Pro Football Focus ... Also selected to the Reese's Senior Bowl watch list and was nominated for the William V. Campbell Trophy, which annually recognizes the top football scholar-athlete in the nation for his combined academic success, football performance and exemplary leadership ... Named to the SEC academic honor roll for the second consecutive season after transferring from Massachusetts in 2018
- Earned Phil Steele All-Independent first-team and All-ECAC second-team honors after starting all 12 games at Massachusetts in 2017 ... Part of an offense that averaged 30.6 points and 432.8 yards per game ... Also spent time at LG and LT over nine games (eight starts) during the 2016 season
