BIRDSEED

- Nominated by the Eagles as their Walter Payton NFL Man of the Year candidate in 2023 ... The award is considered the league’s most prestigious honor and recognizes players who have exhibited excellence on the field as well as a passion to impact the lives of others in their community ... Advocates for mental health awareness while raising money for numerous charities ... Has represented the Travis Manion Foundation, Waterboys, Merging Vets & Players, and Feherty’s Troops First Foundation through the NFL’s *My Cause My Cleats* initiative
- Opened up about his struggles with anxiety and depression in 2021 ... Aimed to help further the conversation about mental health with professional athletes ... Diagnosed with an anxiety disorder in 2008
- Recorded three holiday albums – *A Philly Special Christmas* (2022), *A Philly Special Christmas Special* (2023), and *A Philly Special Christmas Party* (2024) – with **Jason Kelce** and **Jordan Mailata** to raise millions of dollars for local charities ... In 2024, Operation Snowball provided gifts to every student in the Philadelphia public school system ... The success of the hit projects even led to *Billboard* 200 music rankings
- Co-created the OL Masterminds Summit with his friend and OL guru Duke Manyweather in 2018 ... The annual meeting brings together OL from the NFL and college to discuss the technical and mental aspects of their craft, invest in each other and advance OL appreciation
- Converted a horse barn on his property into a world-class home gym that is famously known as the “Bro Barn” ... Hosts groups of Eagles and other NFL players for competitive workouts in the offseason
- Began his collegiate career at Kilgore College (TX), where he served as the Rangers’ QB playing at a 202-pound weight ... After transferring to Oklahoma as a TE in 2009, he redshirted for one year before playing TE and DE in 2010 ... Later settled in as a RT in 2011 prior to moving to the left side of the OL as a senior during the 2012 campaign

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- A six-time **Pro Bowl** selection (2017, ‘18, ‘19, ‘22, ‘23, ‘24), five-time *Associated Press* **All-Pro** honoree (2017, ‘21, ‘22, ‘23, ‘24), three-time NFC Champion (2017, ‘22, ‘24) and two-time Super Bowl Champion (**Super Bowl LII** and **Super Bowl LIX**) ... One of just three players in franchise history to win multiple Super Bowls with the team (only Eagles OL)
- Is one of only two Eagles OTs to earn five *AP* All-Pro accolades, along with **Bob Brown** (five, 1964-68) ... Also selected to the 2nd-most Pro Bowls by an OT in franchise history, behind **Jason Peters** (seven)
- Joined **Jason Peters** (2013-16) and **Frank “Bucko” Kilroy** (1953-55) as the only Eagles OTs to register three consecutive Pro Bowl appearances, having accomplished the feat twice (2017-19 and 2022-24)
- Anchored the **Super Bowl LIX**-winning OL that helped pave the way for **Saquon Barkley** (2,005) to become the ninth member of the league’s 2,000+ yard rushing club in 2024 ... Barkley set an NFL record rushing for 2,504 yards in the regular season and playoffs ... Philadelphia finished with the most combined rushing yards (3,866) in NFL history
- Has blocked for two NFL rushing champions, opening lanes for **LeSean McCoy** in 2013 (1,607) and **Saquon Barkley** in 2024 (2,005)

NOTES TO KNOW

- ▶ Owns the highest *PFF* pass-blocking grade (85.7) among NFL RTs since 2023 ... Is also 1st among RTs in knockdown percentage (0.5%) and 2nd in pressure percentage (4.1%) (min. 1,000 pass-blocking snaps)

2025 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Appeared in 10 contests (10 starts), appearing in 450 offensive snaps and helped pave the way for **Saquon Barkley** to eclipse the 1,000 rushing yard mark for the second consecutive season

2024 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Voted to his sixth career **Pro Bowl** and received his fifth career **All-Pro** selection after leading all NFL RTs in *PFF* pass-blocking grade (88.1), knockdown percentage (0.2%) and pressure percentage (2.2%) ... Allowed 0 sacks and 1 QB hit in 451 pass-blocking opportunities
- ▶ Captained an Eagles OL that helped win the **Super Bowl LIX** Championship while blocking for **Saquon Barkley**, who paced the league with 2,005 rushing yards ... Barkley, who became the ninth all-time player to rush for 2,000+ yards in a season, also set an NFL record with 2,504 rushing yards in the regular season and playoffs ... Philadelphia registered the most combined rushing yards (3,866) in league history
- ▶ Helped the Eagles set a team record with a 103.4 passer rating

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ As a senior in 2012, started 11 games at LT and garnered third-team All-America honors from CBSSports.com and second-team All-Big 12 recognition from the league's coaches ... Anchored a Sooners offense that ranked 12th in the nation with 497.9 yards per game ... Posted 123 knockdowns and led the Big 12 with 19 TD-resulting blocks
- ▶ Started 12 games at RT as a junior in 2011, as Oklahoma ranked 10th nationally in scoring (39.5 ppg), 5th in total offense (512.3 ypg), 5th in passing offense (349.4 ypg) and 7th in fewest sacks allowed (11)
- ▶ Appeared in nine games as a reserve QB at Kilgore College in 2008 ... Completed 32-of-61 (52.5%) attempts for 510 yards, 3 TDs and 7 INTs, while adding 24 yards and 1 TD on 17 rushing attempts
