- ▶ Followed in the footsteps of numerous family members who served their country, including his father, Douglas, who is a Navy veteran ... His wife, Thereasa, was previously stationed in Korea
- ▶ Has supported Legacies Alive through the NFL's *My Cause My Cleats* initiative ... The foundation, which was created by combat veterans, is focused on strengthening and supporting Gold Star families
