- ▶ His father, Joaquin Arcega, and mother each played basketball professionally overseas ... His uncles, Fernando and Jose Arcega, also played basketball for Spain in the 1984 Summer Olympics ... His grandfather, Walter Means, who passed away during the 2021 season, played baseball in the Negro Leagues with the New York Black Yankees
- ▶ Majored in international studies while at Stanford ... Completed an internship at the office of Condoleezza Rice ... Delivered mail, screened calls and responded to emails on behalf of Rice

## 2021 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Produced a career-high 5 special teams tackles with 1 FF and 1 FR in 229 special teams snaps, which ranked 6th on the Eagles ... Also recorded 2 receptions for 36 yards in 170 offensive snaps

## 2020 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Logged 4 receptions for 85 yards (21.3 avg.)
- ▶ Recovered a **Miles Sanders** fumble in the end zone for a TD following Sanders' 74-yard run vs. Bal. (10/18/20)

## 2019 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Finished his rookie campaign with 10 catches for 169 yards (16.9 avg.) and 1 TD, including 4 receptions of 20+ yards
- ▶ Hauled in a 15-yard pass from **Carson Wentz** for his 1st career TD in the second quarter at Mia. (12/1/19)

## COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Registered 135 receptions for 2,219 yards (16.4 avg.) and 28 TDs in 33 career games ... Totaled the 2nd-most receiving TDs in school history, trailing only **Ken Margerum** (30, 1977-80) in that category
- ▶ Garnered All-Pac-12 honors after tying for the 3rd-most receiving TDs (14) among NCAA FBS players and producing the 3rd-most receiving yards (1,059) in the conference as a senior
- ▶ Earned All-Pac-12 honorable mention accolades following his sophomore season in 2017, when he posted a team-high 48 receptions for 781 yards (16.3 avg.) and 9 TDs

## PERSONAL

- ▶ Prepped at Dorman (SC) High School, where he finished as the career leader in receptions (207), receiving yards (3,779) and TDs (38), while averaging 18.2 yards per catch as a three-year varsity starter ... Also lettered in basketball and track and field
