CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Saw action in 94 offensive snaps (8%) over six games (one start) with Philadelphia during the 2020 campaign, allowing 1 sack ... Started his first career game at RT vs. Was. (1/3/21)
- ▶ Originally entered the league as an undrafted free agent with the Eagles in 2019 after he was awarded a waiver from the Department of Defense to pursue his NFL career ... Also spent time with the Cardinals during the 2019 regular season

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Played collegiately at Army, where he was a two-year starter at tackle ... Appeared in 31 games (28 starts) ... Started all 26 games (25 at RT) over his final two seasons with the Black Knights
- ▶ Ranked by *Pro Football Focus* as the nation's 5th-best run-blocking tackle in 2017 ... Invited to participate in the Senior Bowl following the 2017 season, becoming the first Army player to earn that honor ... Helped the Black Knights to the top rushing offense in the country during his senior season (4,710 yards)

BIRDSEED

- ▶ A second lieutenant in the Army, earned a degree in nuclear engineering in 2018 ... Returned to his military career after spending the 2018 season as a graduate assistant for the Black Knights, taking a Basic Officer Leadership Course at Fort Leonard Wood in Missouri ... As an engineering officer, learned everything from demolition to project management and construction ... Upon completion, earned a platoon leader role with the 3rd Chemical Brigade doing Basic Combat Training ... Followed in the footsteps of numerous family members who served their country, including his father, Douglas, who is a Navy veteran
- ▶ Played football, basketball and competed in track and field at West Ashley (SC) High School ... Received three varsity letters as a TE and served as a team captain ... Earned all-state and all-conference honors ... Also played at the U.S. Military Prep Academy in 2013 before enrolling at Army
