- ▶ Known as a skilled handyman who embarks on a number of do-it-yourself home projects with his wife, Brooke ... The couple runs their own home improvement page on Instagram called @dickerson_diys that has amassed over 80k followers
- ▶ Has built an inseparable friendship with Jordan Mailata, who served as Landon’s best man at his wedding during the 2023 offseason
- ▶ Is an Eagle Scout ... Announced on National Signing Day in 2016 that he would finish his Eagle Scout service project installing park benches to restore a recreation center instead of enrolling in college early
- ▶ Learned discipline through martial arts at a young age ... Earned a black belt in karate when he was just 11 years old, becoming the youngest black belt in the history of the dojo that he attended
- ▶ Has supported the Eagles Autism Foundation through the league’s My Cause My Cleats initiative ... The foundation helps support impactful autism research and care to improve the lives of affected individuals and families while aiming to drive scientific breakthroughs

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ A three-time Pro Bowl selection (2022, ‘23, ‘24), two-time NFC Champion (2022, ‘24) and Super Bowl LIX Champion ... Is tied with Brandon Brooks (2016-21) for the most Pro Bowl nods by an Eagles guard
- ▶ Blocked for a Super Bowl LIX-winning OL that helped Saquon Barkley (2,005) become just the ninth player in NFL history to join the 2,000+ yard rushing club in 2024 ... Barkley established a league record with 2,504 rushing yards in the regular season and playoffs ... The Eagles totaled the most combined rushing yards (3,866) in NFL history

- ▶ Saw action in 15 contests (15 starts) en route to helping Saquon Barkley eclipse the 1,000+ yard mark for the second straight season

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Named the recipient of the Rimington Trophy (awarded to the nation’s top center) and voted a unanimous first-team All-American and first-team All-SEC honoree as a fifth-year senior at Alabama in 2020
- ▶ Helped lead Alabama to an undefeated 2020 campaign, which culminated in a CFP National Championship ... Anchored an OL that blocked for the Power 5’s top-ranked scoring offense (48.5 ppg.) ... The Crimson Tide also ranked 1st in the country in pass efficiency rating (198.9) and 2nd in passing offense (358.2 ypg) and total offense (541.6 ypg)



- ▶ Received All-America honorable mention accolades from *Pro Football Focus* in 2019 ... Voted second-team All-SEC as a guard (Associated Press) and center (league's coaches) ... Paved the way for a unit that ranked 2nd in the nation in scoring offense (47.2 ppg), 3rd in passing offense (342.2 ypg) and 6th in total offense (510.8 ypg)
- ▶ Began his collegiate career at Florida State (2016-18)
