

#### **NOTES TO KNOW**

Is the third Heisman Trophy winner ever drafted by the Eagles, joining Jay Berwanger in 1935 (No. 1 overall, negotiating rights traded to Chicago) and Davey O'Brien in 1939 (No. 4 overall)

### **2021 SEASON - EAGLES**

➤ Totaled 6 catches for 71 yards and 1 TD in the 32-6 win at Atl. (9/12/21) ... Tied **DeSean Jackson** (9/7/08 vs. St. Louis) for the team rookie record for receptions in an NFL debut ... Caught an 18-yard TD pass from **Jalen Hurts** on the opening drive, becoming the first Eagles WR to register a TD in their first career game since **Marvin Hargrove** on 9/16/90 vs. Phoenix (34 yards)

#### **COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS**

- Played collegiately at Alabama (2017-20), where he appeared in 54 career games and produced 3,965 yards and 46 TDs on 235 receptions ... Finished as the SEC's all-time leader in receiving yards and receiving TDs (5th-most in NCAA history) ... Recorded the 3rd-most receptions in conference history
- Named the 2020 Heisman Trophy winner after leading the NCAA in receptions (117), receiving yards (1,856) and receiving TDs (23) ... Became the first NCAA WR to win the Heisman Trophy since **Desmond Howard** in 1991 and third player in school history to do so, joining **Mark Ingram** (2009) and **Derrick Henry** (2015)
- Recognized as the 2020 Associated Press Player of the Year (first WR to ever win the award), Biletnikoff Award winner (presented to the nation's top receiver), Paul Hornung Award honoree (awarded to the nation's most versatile player), a unanimous first-team All-American, and the SEC Offensive Player of the Year
- A two-time CFP National Champion (2017 and 2020) ... Voted the Offensive MVP in the 2021 CFP National Championship Game after registering 12 catches for 215 yards and 3 TDs in the first half, shattering seven school, conference and CFP records
- Became the first SEC WR to record multiple career games with 4+ TDs (career-best 5 TDs on 9/28/19 vs. Ole Miss) ... Owns the most 200+ yard receiving games (five) in program history

#### **BIRDSEED**

Prepped at Amite (LA) High School, where he was selected as the Most Outstanding Player in the 2016 LHSAA Class 3A state football championship ... Also voted a 3A All-State honoree and was named the MVP of the Nike New Orleans Regional
