

POST-GAME NOTES PHILADELPHIA EAGLES vs. WASHINGTON FOOTBALL TEAM December 21, 2021

EAGLES IMPROVES TO 5-2 SINCE WEEK 8, TOTALS 519 YARDS IN HOME VICTORY

- Philadelphia has produced a 5-2 record (.714 winning percentage) since Week 8 at Detroit, including 4 of the last 5 contests. The last time the Eagles posted 5+ wins over a 7-game stretch in the regular season was during the final stretch of the 2018 campaign (also 5-2).
- Philadelphia's 519 total yards were its most in a single game since 12/23/18 vs. Houston (also 519).
 The Eagles registered 200+ net passing yards (281) and 200+ net rushing yards (238) in a single game for the first time since 10/1/17 at L.A. Chargers (240 passing, 214 rushing).
 - Philadelphia outgained Washington in total yardage by a 519-237 margin in tonight's victory.
 That is the largest total yards margin by the Eagles since 9/7/08 vs. St. Louis (356).
 - Philadelphia's 7.4 yards per play were its highest mark since 12/22/13 vs. Chicago (8.2).
- The Eagles are the first NFL team to record 175+ rushing yards in 7 consecutive games (franchise record) since the 1985 Chicago Bears (also 7). Philadelphia's 5 games with 200+ rushing yards this season are tied for the 3rd-most in team history, trailing only 1949 (8) and 1950 (6).
 - The Eagles' 238 rushing yards are the 2nd-highest total of the Nick Sirianni era, behind a 242-yard performance in Philadelphia's last home game vs. New Orleans in Week 11.
- The Eagles' defense has allowed 18-or-fewer points in 3 consecutive games for the first time since 10/27/19-11/24/19 (4). Philadelphia limited Washington to 5-or-fewer plays on 8 of 11 drives.

HURTS COMBINES FOR 334 YARDS, RECORDS 5TH CAREER GAME WITH 3+ TDs

- **Jalen Hurts** completed 20-of-26 (76.9%) attempts for 296 yards, 1 TD, 1 INT and a 110.4 passer rating while adding 38 yards (4.8 avg.) and 2 TDs on 8 rushing attempts. He produced his fifth career game with 3+ TDs as well as his fourth career contest with multiple rushing TDs.
 - Hurts has produced team highs in rushing yards (733) and rushing TDs (10) this year. He is the third QB in NFL history to rush for 700+ yards and 10+ TDs in a season, joining **Kyler Murray** in 2020 (819 yards, 11 TDs) and **Cam Newton** in 2011 (706 yards, 14 TDs).
 - Hurts now owns the single-season franchise record for rushing TDs by a QB (10) after surpassing Michael Vick during the 2010 campaign (9).

GOEDERT POSTS CAREER-HIGH 135 YARDS ON 7 RECEPTIONS (19.3 AVG.)

- **Dallas Goedert** caught a team-leading 7 passes for a career-high 135 yards (19.3 avg.). Goedert's 135 yards are the most by an Eagles TE since **Zach Ertz** on 11/11/18 vs. Dallas (145). He is the first Eagle with 100+ yards in back-to-back games since Ertz from 9/30/18-10/7/18.
 - o For the season, Goedert has registered a career-high 731 receiving yards.

SANDERS RECORDS CAREER-HIGH 131 RUSHING YARDS (7.3 AVG.)

- Miles Sanders finished with a career-high 131 rushing yards on 18 attempts (7.3 avg.).
 - Sanders' 131 rushing yards are the most by an Eagle since LeGarrette Blount's 136-yard performance on 10/1/17 at L.A. Chargers. He also became the first Eagle to post 100+ rushing yards in consecutive games since LeSean McCoy from 11/23/14-11/27/14.

ELLIOTT JOINS EAGLES' 500-POINT CLUB, EXTENDS FG STREAK

- Jake Elliott connected on 2-of-2 FGs and 3-of-3 PATs in tonight's victory.
 - Elliott has converted 41 consecutive kicks (FGs and PATs) dating back to Week 8. Overall, he
 has made 17 straight FGs, which is tied for the 4th-longest streak in Eagles history, trailing
 only Alex Henery (22 in 2012), himself (20 in 2018-19) and Caleb Sturgis (18 in 2016).

• In addition, Elliott became just the third player in franchise history to reach 500 career points (503), joining **David Akers** (1,323, 1999-2010) and **Bobby Walston** (881, 1951-62). Doing so in 77 games, Elliott became the fastest player in Eagles history to accumulate 500 career points.

GREG WARD a.k.a. "MR. DECEMBER"

• **Greg Ward** sealed the 27-17 victory with a game-clinching, 19-yard TD reception in the fourth quarter. The score marked his 5th career TD in the month of December, which includes 3 TDs over a 3-game stretch during the final month of the 2020 season as well as a game-winning TD at Washington to keep the team's playoffs hopes alive during the 2019 campaign. Overall, Ward has totaled 35 receptions for 361 yards (10.3 avg.) and 5 TDs in 11 career December contests.

MORE FROM THE GAME

- **Jason Kelce** appeared in his 156th career game, tying **Jerry Sisemore** (1973-84) for the 4th-most by an OL in Eagles history. He also started in his 119th consecutive regular-season game, which is the longest active streak among NFL centers and longest since **Chris Myers** from 2007-14 (123).
- Fletcher Cox produced a season-high 1.5 sacks against Washington QB Garrett Gilbert.
- Jalen Reagor finished with a career-high 57 yards on 3 receptions (19.0 avg.).
- **Jordan Howard** added 69 yards on 15 attempts (4.6 avg.) in his return.
