BY THE NUMBERS

283.0

Philadelphia's defense ranks 4th in the NFL in total yards allowed per game (283.0), trailing only Carolina (191.0), Buffalo (234.0) and Denver (251.5).

162.0

The Eagles have produced the 2nd-ranked rushing offense (162.0 ypg) in the NFL (150+ rushing yards in back-to-back games), behind Baltimore (220.0 ypg).

34.8%

Since 2017. Philadelphia ranks 2nd in the NFL in third-down defense (34.8%) (5th in the NFL in 2021 -32.1%), trailing only Minnesota (33.5%).

11.5

The Eagles rank T-2nd in the NFL in scoring defense (11.5), behind Carolina (10.0). Philadelphia allowed 6 points in their last road game (Week 1 at Atlanta).

5.0

The Eagles defense has limited opponents to just 5.0 yards per pass attempt, which ranks 2nd in the NFL, trailing only Buffalo (4.2) in that category.

Philadelphia is the only NFL team that has not turned the ball over this season. The last time the Eagles had 0 giveaways through two games was in 2016.

NOTES TO KNOW

EAGLES ON PRIMETIME BIRDS

Philadelphia has produced the 2nd-highest primetime winning percentage (.684, 13-6) in the NFL since 2017, trailing only Seattle (.722, 13-5). The Eagles have won 4 of their last 6 primetime matchups.

ELLIOTT IN THE RECORD BOOK

Jake Elliott is tied with Sam Baker (1964-69) for the 3rd-most FGs (90) in Eagles history, trailing only David Akers (294, 1999-2010) and Paul McFadden (91, 1984-87). He is also 6 points shy of tying Brian Westbrook (410, 2002-09) for 7th place on the franchise's all-time scoring list.

- Derek Barnett has produced 7 tackles (6 solo), 5 QB hits, 4 TFLs, 3.0 sacks and 1 FF in 4 career games against the Cowboys.
- Fletcher Cox has totaled 11 tackles (8 solo), 7 QB hits, 3.5 sacks and 2 FFs in his previous 5 games vs. Dallas.
- Ryan Kerrigan has contributed to sacks in 12 of 19 career games against the Cowboys. In his last 10 games vs. Dallas, Kerrigan has 29 tackles (19 solo), 11 QB hits, 10 TFLs, 9.0 sacks and 1 FF.
