BIRDSEED

- Hosts the DeVonta Smith & Friends Celebrity Softball Game annually at the Lehigh Valley IronPigs (Philadelphia Phillies' Triple-A affiliate) stadium in Allentown, PA ... The fundraiser's teams feature a number of Eagles teammates and other players from across the league
- Is the son of Christina Smith-Sylve, who is a social worker, and Kelvin Dickerson, who manages a car-detailing business ... Also has a younger brother, Christian, who plays RB at Amite (LA) High School ... Bought a brand new home for his mother during the 2021 offseason
- Credits much of his success to his barber, Vincent Sanders, who became his mentor growing up ... Sanders helped reinforce that football was meant to be a part of Smith's future and drove him to camps
- Considers himself an excellent cook ... Admits that he doesn't always have the patience for cooking, so if he is making something, it means he really wants whatever it is ... Loves making crawfish étouffée from scratch or jambalaya ... Says his mother taught him how to cook
- Has represented the Eagles Autism Foundation through the NFL's *My Cause My Cleats* campaign ... The foundation helps support impactful autism research and care to improve the lives of affected individuals and families while aiming to drive scientific breakthroughs

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Produced 100 yards on 7 receptions (14.3 avg.) in Super Bowl LVII vs. Kansas City on 2/12/23, becoming the third player in Eagles history to have 100+ receiving yards in a Super Bowl ... Joined **Terrell Owens** (122) in Super Bowl XXXIX vs. New England on 2/6/05 and also **Corey Clement** (100) in Super Bowl LII at New England on 2/4/18
- Totaled the most receptions (95) by a WR in Eagles history in 2022
- With a career-high 1,196 receiving yards in 2022, teamed up with **A.J. Brown** (1,496) to become the Eagles' first 1,000+ yard receiving duo
- Set the team rookie record for receiving yards (916) in 2021, breaking the previous mark owned by **DeSean Jackson** in 2008 (912)

2023 SEASON - EAGLES

- Recorded 1,066 receiving yards on 81 receptions (13.2 avg) and tied a career high with 7 TDs in 2023 ... 2023 marked the second consecutive season that **DeVonta Smith** and **A.J. Brown** each posted 1,000+ yards ... Smith and Brown finished as the only WR duo in the NFL's top 20 receiving leaders (Smith: 20th, Brown: 5th)
- Caught 4 passes for 79 yards (19.8 avg) in the victory vs. New York (12/25/23) ... Smith produced a 36-yard TD in the second quarter on a throw from **Jalen Hurts**, marking Smith's 4th TD reception of 25+ yards this season, tied for 2nd in the NFL
- Hauled in 7 receptions for 106 yards (15.1 avg) in the victory vs. Buffalo (11/26/23) ... Caught a 15-yard TD pass from **Jalen Hurts** to trim the deficit and help Philadelphia go on to win in overtime
- Led the Eagles with 99 yards on 6 receptions (16.5 avg) in the comeback victory at Kansas City (11/20/23) ... Hauled in a 41-yard pass from **Jalen**

Hurts in the fourth quarter that led to a **Jalen Hurts** 1-yard TD run and gave the Eagles a lead they would not surrender

- ▶ Caught a 29-yard TD pass from **Jalen Hurts** in the third quarter to take the lead in the Eagles win vs. Dallas (11/5/23) ... The catch marked his 200th reception in only his 43rd career game, making him the 2nd fastest Eagle behind **Jordan Matthews** (41 Games) to reach this milestone
- ▶ Totaled 99 yards on 7 receptions (14.1 avg) in the victory at Washington (10/29/23) ... Caught a game-tying 38-yard TD pass from **Jalen Hurts** in the fourth quarter
- ▶ Produced 131 yards and 1 TD on 4 receptions (32.8 avg.) in the 34-28 win vs. Minnesota (9/14/23) ... Tallied a 54-yarder on the Eagles' opening drive and hauled in a 63-yard TD pass from **Jalen Hurts** in the third quarter ... Became the first Eagle with multiple 50+ yard catches in a game since **DeSean Jackson** on 9/8/19 vs. Washington
- ▶ Hauled in 7 passes for 47 yards and 1 TD in the win at New England (9/10/23) ... Caught a 5-yard TD pass during the first quarter

2022 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Established career highs in receptions (95), receiving yards (1,196) and receiving TDs (7) ... Hauled in the most passes ever by an Eagles WR and joined **A.J. Brown** (1,496) as the first combo in franchise history to each post 1,000+ receiving yards in a season ... Ranked among the top 10 NFL WRs in receptions (10th) and receiving yards (8th)
- ▶ Paced the team with 196 receiving yards in the playoffs ... Turned in a 100-yard performance in Super Bowl LVII vs. Kansas City on 2/12/23, becoming the third Eagle to register 100+ receiving yards in a Super Bowl ... **Terrell Owens** (122 in Super Bowl XXXIX vs. New England on 2/6/05) and **Corey Clement** (100 in Super Bowl LII at New England on 2/4/18) are the only other Eagles to accomplish the feat

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Played collegiately at Alabama (2017-20), where he caught 235 passes for 3,965 yards and 46 TDs in 54 career games ... Finished as the SEC's all-time leader in receiving yards and TDs (5th-most in NCAA history)

- ▶ Voted the 2020 Heisman Trophy winner after leading the NCAA in receptions (117), receiving yards (1,856) and receiving TDs (23) ... Became the first WR to capture the Heisman Trophy since Desmond Howard in 1991 ... Also became just the third player in Crimson Tide history to do so, joining **Derrick Henry** (2015) and **Mark Ingram** (2009)
- ▶ Recognized as the 2020 *Associated Press* Player of the Year (first WR to ever win the award) ... Also honored as the Biletnikoff Award winner (presented to the nation's top receiver), Paul Hornung Award recipient (awarded to the nation's most versatile player), a unanimous first-team All-America selection and SEC Offensive Player of the Year
- ▶ A two-time CFP National Champion (2017 and 2020) ... Selected as the Offensive MVP of the 2021 CFP National Championship Game after posting 12 receptions for 215 yards (17.9 avg.) and 3 TDs in the first half, shattering seven school, conference and CFP records
