BIRDSEED

- ► Hosts the DeVonta Smith & Friends Celebrity Softball Game annually at the Lehigh Valley IronPigs (Philadelphia Phillies' Triple-A affiliate) stadium in Allentown, PA ... The fundraiser's teams feature a number of Eagles teammates and other players from across the league
- ▶ Is the son of Christina Smith-Sylve, who is a social worker, and Kelvin Dickerson, who manages a car-detailing business ... Also has a younger brother, Christian, who plays RB at Amite (LA) High School ... Bought a brand new home for his mother during the 2021 offseason
- Credits much of his success to his barber, Vincent Sanders, who became his mentor growing up ... Sanders helped reinforce that football was meant to be a part of Smith's future and drove him to camps
- Considers himself an excellent cook ... Admits that he doesn't always have the patience for cooking, so if he is making something, it means he really wants whatever it is ... Loves making crawfish étouffée from scratch or jambalaya ... Says his mother taught him how to cook
- Has represented the Eagles Autism Foundation through the NFL's My Cause My Cleats campaign ... The foundation helps support impactful autism research and care to improve the lives of affected individuals and families while aiming to drive scientific breakthroughs

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Logged the most single-game receiving yards (148) in Eagles playoff history in the NFC Wild Card Playoff at Tampa Bay on 1/15/24
- Produced 100 yards on 7 receptions (14.3 avg.) in Super Bowl LVII vs. Kansas City on 2/12/23, becoming the third player in Eagles history to have 100+ receiving yards in a Super Bowl ... Joined Terrell Owens (122) in Super Bowl XXXIX vs. New England on 2/6/05 and also Corey Clement (100) in Super Bowl LII at New England on 2/4/18
- With a career-high 1,196 receiving yards in 2022, teamed up with A.J. Brown (1,496) to become the Eagles' first 1,000+ yard receiving duo ... The tandem then repeated the feat during the 2023 campaign
- ► Totaled a career-high 95 receptions in 2022, marking a then-franchise record for the most catches by a WR (A.J. Brown - 106 in 2023)
- Set the team rookie record for receiving yards (916) in 2021, breaking the previous mark owned by **DeSean Jackson** in 2008 (912)

NOTES TO KNOW

- ▶ Is one of seven NFL WRs with 80+ catches, 1,000+ yards and 7+ TDs in each of the last two seasons (2022-23), joining Davante Adams, A.J. Brown, Ja'Marr Chase, Stefon Diggs, Tyreek Hill and CeeDee Lamb
- Holds franchise records for the most receptions (240) and receiving yards (3,178) by an Eagle during their first three NFL seasons

2024 SEASON - EAGLES

► Totaled 87 yards and 1 TD on 4 receptions (21.8 avg) in the 28-23 win against Jacksonville (11/3/24) ... His 25-yard TD extended Philadelphia's lead with 7:43 remaining in the fourth quarter

- ► Hauled in 6 passes for 85 yards (14.2 avg) including a 45-yard TD pass from **Jalen Hurts** to give the Eagles the lead in the fourth quarter of the 37-17 win over the Bengals (10/27/24)
- Caught 3 passes for 64 yards (21.3 avg) in the 20-16 win over Cleveland ... His 45-yard catch-and-run TD in the fourth quarter gave the Eagles a lead they would not surrender
- Registered 7 catches for 79 yards in the Eagles 15-12 win over New Orleans (9/22/24) ... He recorded 7+ receptions and 75+ yards in three consecutive games, becoming one of only five Eagles to accomplish that feat since the 1970 merger, joining Irving Fryar (four, 1996), Harold Jackson (four, 1971), A.J. Brown (2023), and Zach Ertz (2015 and 2019)

2023 SEASON - EAGLES

- ► Finished with 1,066 yards and a career-high-tying 7 TDs on 81 catches (13.2 avg.) ... Marked his second consecutive 1,000+ yard campaign ... Also tied for the 3rd-most receiving TDs of 25+ yards (4) in the NFL
- Produced the most single-game receiving yards (148) in Eagles playoff history in the NFC Wild Card Playoff at Tampa Bay (1/15/24)
- ► Hauled in 7 receptions for 106 yards (15.1 avg.) in the 37-34 win vs. Buffalo (11/26/23) ... Caught a 15-yard TD in the fourth quarter to trim the Eagles' deficit during the come-from-behind OT victory
- ▶ Led the Eagles with 99 yards on 6 receptions (16.5 avg.) in the 21-17, fourth-quarter comeback at Kansas City (11/20/23) ... Caught a 41-yard pass during the fourth quarter that set up for a 1-yard rushing TD by Jalen Hurts that gave the Eagles a lead they did not surrender
- Produced 131 yards and 1 TD on 4 receptions (32.8 avg.) in the 34-28 win vs. Minnesota (9/14/23) ... Posted a 54-yard catch on the Eagles' opening drive and secured a 63-yard TD pass from Jalen Hurts in the third quarter ... Became the first Eagle with multiple 50+ yard catches in a game since DeSean Jackson on 9/8/19 vs. Washington

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Played collegiately at Alabama (2017-20), where he caught 235 passes for 3,965 yards and 46 TDs in 54 career games ... Finished as the SEC's all-time leader in receiving yards and TDs (5th-most in NCAA history)
- Voted the 2020 Heisman Trophy winner after leading the NCAA in receptions (117), receiving yards (1,856) and receiving TDs (23) ... Became the first WR to capture the Heisman Trophy since Desmond Howard in 1991 ... Also became just the third player in Crimson Tide history to do so, joining Derrick Henry (2015) and Mark Ingram (2009)
- Recognized as the 2020 Associated Press Player of the Year (first WR to ever win the award) ... Also honored as the Biletnikoff Award winner (presented to the nation's top receiver), Paul Hornung Award recipient (awarded to the nation's most versatile player), a unanimous first-team All-America selection and SEC Offensive Player of the Year

▶ A two-time CFP National Champion (2017 and 2020) ... Selected as the Offensive MVP of the 2021 CFP National Championship Game after posting 12 receptions for 215 yards (17.9 avg.) and 3 TDs in the first half, shattering seven school, conference and CFP records
