COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Named the recipient of the Rimington Trophy (presented to the nation's top C) and voted a unanimous first-team All-American and first-team All-SEC honoree as a fifth-year senior in 2020
- ▶ Helped lead Alabama to an undefeated 2020 season and a CFP National Championship ... Anchored an OL that blocked for the Power 5's top-ranked scoring offense (48.5 ppg) ... The Crimson Tide also ranked 1st in pass efficiency rating (198.9) and 2nd in passing offense (358.2 ypg) and total offense (541.6 ypg)
- ▶ Received honorable mention All-America recognition from *Pro Football Focus* in 2019 ... Also voted second-team All-SEC as a G (*Associated Press*) and C (league coaches) ... Paved the way for a unit that ranked 2nd nationally in scoring (47.2 ppg), 3rd in passing (342.2 ypg) and 6th in total offense (510.8 ypg)
- ▶ Began his collegiate career at Florida State (2016-18)

BIRDSEED

- ▶ Operating on a college budget, made an economical decision to replace his damaged front bumper with a wooden railroad tie and bolted a "BAMA" license plate on it ... The 'bumper' gained noteworthy attention on campus and on social media
- ▶ In 2021, upon learning the story of Captain Brian Wolnewitz, a firefighter who was diagnosed with Stage 4 lung cancer, organized the Landon Dickerson Bama Bumper Fundraiser ... Auctioned his famous 'bumper' signed by some of his teammates, as well as other items, with all proceeds benefiting Wolnewitz's family
- ▶ Converted his carport into a gym for Alabama teammates during the COVID-19 pandemic ... Purchased equipment out of his own pocket (including a cold tub), drew up workouts on whiteboards, scheduled time slots for 40 players per day, stocked recovery shakes, and additionally provided sanitary services
- ▶ Is an Eagle Scout ... Announced on National Signing Day in 2016 that he would complete his Eagle Scout service project building and installing park benches to restore a recreation center near his hometown instead of enrolling in college early
- ▶ Prepped at South Caldwell (NC) High School ... Led the program to the third round of the state 4A playoffs and collected *USA Today* All-USA North Carolina First-Team and All-Northwestern 3A-4A honors as a senior ... A five-star prospect who was tabbed as the nation's No. 1 offensive guard by *Rivals*
- ▶ Learned discipline through martial arts at a young age ... Earned a black belt in karate when he was 11 years old, becoming the youngest black belt in the history of the dojo he attended ... Volunteered at the dojo during his free time in high school
