#### 1962 NFL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME GREEN BAY 16, NY GIANTS 7

### December 30, 1962, at New York. Attendance 64,892

The Giants outgained the Packers 291 yards to 244, but New York lost in the NFL Championship Game for the fourth time in five years, bowing to Green Bay 16-7.

The key figure for the Packers was fullback Jim Taylor, who tied the NFL playoff record with 31 carries, while gaining 85 yards and scoring the Packers' only touchdown. The score came in the second quarter, at a point when the Packers already led 3-0 on a 26-yard field goal by all-pro guard Jerry Kramer. Linebacker Dan Currie forced a fumble from Giants halfback Phil King, and the Packers recovered at the New York 28. On first down, Paul Hornung threw a halfback pass to Boyd Dowler, which was good for 21 yards. On the next play, Taylor blasted through the middle for a touchdown.

The Giants made their move in the third quarter. The Packers had to punt from deep in their own territory, and Erich Barnes blocked Max McGee's kick, which Jim Collier recovered in the end zone for a touchdown. However, they could not score again, while Kramer added two field goals to insure the Packers of their second consecutive championship.
