## 1967 NFL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

### GREEN BAY 21, DALLAS 17

December 31, 1967, at Green Bay. Attendance 50,861

In some of the most difficult conditions in the history of the playoffs - a temperature at kickoff of -13 degrees and a 15-mile-per-hour wind -- Bart Starr scored on a one-yard quarterback sneak with 13 seconds left to give the Packers a 21-17 victory against the Dallas Cowboys.

The Packers jumped to a 14-0 lead in the second quarter, as Starr found Boyd Dowler with an eight-yard touchdown pass in the first period, and a 46-yard scoring toss in the second. But the Cowboys came back, as defensive tackle Willie Townes drilled Starr, who fumbled, and defensive end George Andrie scooped up the ball and returned it seven yards for a touchdown. A field goal by Danny Villanueva narrowed the halftime margin to 14-10.

On the initial play of the fourth quarter, the Cowboys took the lead. Halfback Dan Reeves, who had been a quarterback at South Carolina, threw a 50-yard touchdown pass to Lance Rentzel.

The Packers started their final drive at their 32, with 4:50 left. The big gain in the 12-play drive came when fullback Chuck Mercein took a short pass from Starr and rumbled 19 yards to the Dallas 11. Mercein then powered to the 3. Three plays later, behind blocks by guard Jerry Kramer and center Ken Bowman, Starr slid across the goal line for the victory.

## Super Bowl II

### Green Bay 33, Oakland 14

January 14, 1968, Orange Bowl, Miami, FL

Attendance: 75,546

The Green Bay Packers won their second straight AFL-NFL World Championship Game, or, as it was by now generally if unofficially termed, Super Bowl. In besting the Oakland Raiders, 33-14, Vince Lombardi's team followed a script similar to the one they had used the year before in their victory over Kansas City -- take a lead in the first half and wrap up the game in the third quarter. And again, as he had the year before, Packer quarterback Bart Starr put on a performance that earned him the game's MVP award. He completed 13 of 24 passes for 202 yards and a touchdown.

Green Bay took their first possession 34 yards in 11 plays to the Oakland 32. Don Chandler kicked a 39-yard field goal to put the Packers in front 3-0. The next time they got the ball, the Packers started at their own three and went 82 yards in a drive that consumed 8:40 of the clock. From the 20, Chandler kicked his second field goal, raising the score to 6-0.

The Raiders were held without a first down, and Green Bay took the ball at its own 38. On the first play from scrimmage, Starr passed to Boyd Dowler. The Packer end cut inside Kent McCloughan who was playing a tight man-to-man, took the football on the fly, and raced the rest of the way for a touchdown.

In danger of a blow-out, Oakland fought back, driving 78 yards in eight plays. Daryle Lamonica's 23-yard pass to Bill Miller tightened the score to 13-7. However, shortly before the end of the first half ended, Oakland's Rodger Bird fumbled a fair catch at midfield. With six seconds on the clock, Chandler kicked his third field goal, this one from 43 yards out.

Any hope the Raiders might have harbored for a second-half comeback was dashed on the Packers' second possession of the period. Green Bay rumbled 82 yards in 11 plays. Starr kept the drive alive by twice completing third down passes. Donny Anderson wrapped up the drive by slashing two-yards into the end zone. Before the third quarter ended, Chandler added his fourth field goal of the day -- 31 yards -- to make it 26-7 Green Bay.

Oakland tried desperately to catch up with Lamonica passes, but early in the final quarter, Green Bay's Herb Adderley stepped in front of Fred Biletnikoff for an interception and then ran unmolested 60 yards for a final Packer touchdown. A successful Lamonica toss to Miller for 23 yards and a touchdown with 9:13 remaining was too little and far too late.

With the Packers' second consecutive convincing victory, several critics argued that the AFL was not ready to compete with

the stronger NFL teams. That idea was underlined when Lombardi allowed that his club's win "wasn't our best."

A few days after the game, celebrations in Tittletown, U.S.A. were tempered by another Lombardi announcement -- that he would retire as Green Bay coach and devote his time exclusively to being the team's general manager.
