NOTES TO KNOW

THURSDAY NIGHT FOOTBALL

- Dating back to 2016, Philadelphia has won 6 of its last 7 Thursday games, with 5 of those 6 wins happening on short weeks (began the 2018 season on Thursday night). Overall, the Eagles' .857 winning percentage in Thursday games leads the NFL in that span.

BY THE NUMBERS

7-0

Philadelphia is 7-0 for just the second time in team history, having previously done so in 2004 under **Andy Reid**. The Eagles have never started 8-0.

+14

The Eagles' league-leading +14 turnover margin is their best figure through 7 games in franchise history (NFL-high 16 takeaways, league-low 2 giveaways).

53

Philadelphia owns the 2nd-most points off takeaways (53, the Eagles' most through 7 games since posting 60 in 2015) in the NFL, behind New England (68).

15.6

Philadelphia ranks 2nd in the NFL in *defensive* points allowed per game (15.6, including 17-or-fewer in 6 consecutive games), trailing only Buffalo (14.0).

41.1%

The Eagles lead the league in opponent three-and-out percentage (41.1%), forcing 30 three-and-outs on 73 defensive drives through 7 games this season.

2

Philadelphia is just the second NFL team since at least 1940 to have 2-or-fewer turnovers through 7 games, joining the 2017 Chiefs (1 turnover).

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

MOST INTERCEPTIONS

- C.J. Gardner-Johnson** is tied for the most INTs (career-high 4) in the NFL this season, collecting each pick over the last 3 games. He is the first Eagle to record an INT in 3 consecutive games since **Rodney McLeod** in 2017.

LEADS ALL NFL PLAYERS IN OPP. PASSER RATING (37.2) (MIN. 25 TARGETS) ... LEADS LEAGUE WITH 127 PDs SINCE 2013

HAASON REDDICK

ONLY NFL PLAYER WITH 5.0+ SACKS (5.5), 3+ FFs AND 2+ FRs ... ALSO TIED FOR MOST STRIP SACKS IN LEAGUE (3)

MILES SANDERS

RANKS 5TH IN NFL IN RUSHING YARDS PER GAME (80.4) ... RANKS 3RD IN RUSHING AVG. (5.3) SINCE 2021 (MIN. 200 ATT.)



QUICK HITS

- According to *PFF*, **Lane Johnson** has not given up a sack since Week 11 of 2020 or a QB hit since Week 7 of 2021. He leads all NFL tackles with a 0.1% knockdown percentage since 2021 (0 sacks and 1 QB hit allowed in 674 pass-blocking snaps).
- Jason Kelce** has started 129 consecutive regular-season games, which is the longest streak by an NFL center since **Casey Wiegman's** 175-game stretch from 2001-11. Kelce's streak ranks 4th in Eagles history, behind **Jon Runyan** (144, 2000-08), **Herman Edwards** (135, 1977-85) and **Jerry Sisemore** (127, 1974-82).
