BIRDSEED

- Is very close with his mother, Shay Allen, and two younger brothers, Donovan and Yashua ... Shay was originally a huge fan of the Eagles
- ▶ Credits his mother for getting him into football ... When he hit a growth spurt before entering 10th grade, she struggled to keep pace with his increased appetite and would often come home from her second job to find the refrigerator and cabinets almost bare ... Shay was sold on Mallard Creek (NC) High School's football team when she learned that summer practices included free breakfast and lunch
- ▶ At the 2022 NFL Combine, recorded a 4.78 time in the 40-yard dash, which was the fastest by any player over 330 pounds since 2006 and is believed to be one of the fastest times ever for a player his size ... In addition, his 10'3" standing broad jump is thought to be the record for a 300-pound player at the NFL Combine ... Earned a perfect 10 on the Relative Athletic Score due to his rare measurables
- ▶ Represented Camp Sunshine and Northwest Victims Services through the league's *My Cause My Cleats* initiative ... Camp Sunshine offers retreats for children with life-threatening illnesses to enable hope and promote joy among them and their families ... Northwest Victims Services is a nonprofit organization that provides services to victims of crime in Philadelphia while promoting safety in the community

- ► A member of the Eagles' **Super Bowl LIX**-winning defense in 2024
- ▶ Voted to the PFWA **All-Rookie** Team in 2022 ... Contributed to a group that helped Philadelphia earn a Super Bowl LVII appearance

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Played collegiately at Georgia (2018-21), totaling 91 tackles (37 solo), 12.5 TFLs, 7.0 sacks and 1 PD in 47 career games (33 starts) ... A key member of the 2021 CFP National Championship-winning defense
- ▶ Honored with the Outland Trophy (nation's best interior lineman) and Chuck Bednarik Award (best defensive player in college football) as a senior in 2021 ... Also voted first-team All-America by the *Associated Press* and earned first-team All-SEC honors (media and coaches) after recording 32 tackles (17 solo), 5.5 TFLs, 2.0 sacks and 1 PD
