- ▶ Launched the A.J. Brown Foundation with a mission to forge a pathway for success that promotes resilience, confidence and a brighter future for youth ... The foundation developed a reading and literacy program and also supports scholarships for empowering deserving students in their pursuit of post-secondary educational opportunities
- Opened up about his battle with depression in a video he posted on social media during the 2021 season ... "I wanted to encourage others to seek help whenever they are down. I didn't take into consideration what depression really was. Us as men, our feelings aren't too much cared about. Get things off your chest. It's okay to talk to someone. You have to take care of your brain just like you take care of your body." ... Has engaged with students in different settings across the country to discuss his journey with purpose, discipline and mental health
- A standout high school baseball player who was selected by the San Diego Padres as an outfielder in the 19th round (564th overall) of the 2016 MLB Draft ... Participated in the Padres' extended spring training during the summers of 2016, 2017 and 2018 while in college

## **CAREER HIGHLIGHTS**

- ► A three-time **Pro Bowl** honoree (2019, '22, '23), three-time *Associated Press* **All-Pro** (2022, '23, '24) and **Super Bowl LIX** Champion who has reached 1,000+ receiving yards in five of his first six NFL seasons
- ▶ Is the only Eagle to post multiple seasons with 1,400+ receiving yards, accomplishing the feat in back-to-back years (1,496 in 2022 and 1,456 in 2023) with each of the top two marks in franchise history
- Logged the most receptions (career-high 106) ever by a WR in Eagles history in 2023 ... Also set an NFL record with 125+ receiving yards in six consecutive games, eclipsing a mark that was previously shared by Calvin Johnson (2012) and Pat Studstill (1966) (five games)

- Leads the NFL in receiving average (15.4) since 2022 (min. 200 receptions) ... Also ranks 4th in receiving yards (4,039), behind **Tyreek Hill** (4,508), **Justin Jefferson** (4,416) and **CeeDee Lamb** (4,412)
- ► Has produced 1,000+ receiving yards in three consecutive seasons ... Is tied for the 3rd-most 100+ yard receiving performances (17) since 2022, trailing only Justin Jefferson (20) and Tyreek Hill (18)
- Ranks 1st in the NFL in 50+ yard catches (15) since his rookie year in 2019 ... His 10 receiving TDs of 50+ yards are also 3rd overall during that window, behind Ja'Marr Chase (13) and Tyreek Hill (11)

#### 2024 SEASON - EAGLES

- Voted second-team All-Pro by the Associated Press after leading all NFL WRs with a 91.1 PFF offensive grade (min. 600 snaps) ... Paced the offense with 1,079 yards on 67 receptions with 7 TDs in the regular season ... Ranked 1st in the league in receiving average (16.1) (min. 60 catches) as well as 3rd in receiving yards per game (83.0), behind Ja'Marr Chase (100.5) and Justin Jefferson (90.2) (min. 13 games)
- Despite missing four games due to injury, finished tied for the most 100+ yard receiving performances (five) in the NFL ... Registered 100+ yards in Week 1 vs. Green Bay (season-high 119 with 1 TD), Week 6 vs. Cleveland (116 with 1 TD), Week 10 at Dallas (109), Week 12 at L.A. Rams (109 with 1 TD) and Week 15 vs. Pittsburgh (110 with 1 TD)
- Hauled in 3 passes for 43 yards and 1 TD in the 40-22 win vs. Kansas City in Super Bowl LIX (2/9/25) ... Is the only Eagle to record receiving TDs in multiple Super Bowls (also Super Bowl LVII in 2022)
- ► Totaled the 3rd-most receiving yards (924) in the league during Weeks 6-17, trailing only Ja'Marr Chase (1,119) and Justin Jefferson (1,029)

- ▶ Played collegiately at Ole Miss, where he left as the program's all-time leading receiver with 2,984 yards ... Also finished his Rebels career 3rd in school history in receptions (189) and 5th in receiving TDs (19)
