FLYING AROUND ON OFFENSE



Philadelphia scored a franchise-record 477 points in 2022, including team records in total TDs (59), scrimmage TDs (57) and rushing TDs (32). The Eagles' 32 rushing TDs tied for the 3rd-most in league history, trailing the 1962 Packers (36) as well as the 1976 Steelers (33). Their 39 rushing TDs, including the playoffs, are the most in NFL history.

THE EAGLES SET A SINGLE-SEASON FRANCHISE RECORD WITH AN NFL-LEADING 70 SACKS THIS SEASON. SINCE 1982, WHEN SACKS BECAME AN OFFICIAL STATISTIC, ONLY THE 1984 BEARS (72) AND 1989 VIKINGS (71) HAVE TOTALED MORE.

BY THE NUMBERS

14-3

Philadelphia set a single-season franchise record with 14 wins this year. The Eagles finished tied with Kansas City for the best record in the NFL (14-3).

The Eagles are one of three franchises in the league to appear in the playoffs in five of the last six seasons, joining Kansas City (six) and Buffalo (five).

45.9%

Philadelphia totaled the 4th-highest third-down conversion rate (45.9%) in the NFL, setting a new club record in that category (previously 45.7% in 2021).

301.5

The Eagles produced the No. 2 total defense (301.5 ypg) in the NFL this season, which is the club's lowest figure since the 2008 campaign (274.3 ypg).

159

T.J. Edwards posted a career-high 159 total tackles, which finished 7th overall in the NFL and were the 2nd-most by an Eagle in the last 31 seasons.

Jason Kelce has earned five first-team All-Pro selections, joining Dermontti Dawson (six) and Mike Webster as the only NFL centers to do so.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

DEFENSE IN THE POSTSEASON

The Eagles are the first NFL team to allow 7-or-fewer points multiple times in a playoff run since the 2000 Baltimore Ravens (three). Furthermore, the last time Philadelphia gave up 7-or-fewer points in consecutive playoff games was during the 1948 and 1949 NFL Championships.
