EAGLES ON PRIMETIME

Philadelphia owns the 4th-best primetime winning percentage (.654, 17-9) in the NFL dating back to the 2017 campaign, including a 5-2 mark on Monday Night Football. Overall, the Eagles have registered a 3-0 record in primetime games this season.

SETTING THE STANDARD

Since the 1970 merger, only four coaches have started 8-0 in their first or second career year as a head coach: Nick Sirianni in 2022 (8-0, Eagles), Sean McVay in 2018 (8-0, Rams), Jim Caldwell in 2009 (14-0, Colts) and George Seifert in 1990 (10-0, 49ers).

BY THE NUMBERS

8-0

Philadelphia is 8-0 for the first time in franchise history. The Eagles are the 28th team since the 1970 merger to start a season with 8 straight wins.

BIRDS

+15

The Eagles rank 1st in the NFL in turnover differential (15+). Philadelphia has 3 giveaways, its fewest in the first 8 games of a season in team history.

60

Philadelphia has produced the 2nd-most points off takeaways (60) in the NFL, marking the club's highest total through 8 games since the 2015 season (67).

15.8

Philadelphia is tied for 2nd in the NFL in defensive points allowed per game (15.8, including 17-or-fewer in 7 consecutive games), trailing only Buffalo (14.8).

68.0

The Eagles have limited opponents to just a 68.0 passer rating through the first 8 games of the season, marking the best defensive figure in the league.

28.1

Philadelphia ranks 2nd in the NFL in points per game (28.1), which is the team's 3rd-best mark through 8 games in club history (29.3 in 2014, 29.0 in 2017).

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

MOST INTERCEPTIONS

C.J. Gardner-Johnson leads the NFL with a career-high 5 INTs, the most by an Eagles safety since Greg Jackson in 1994 (6). He is also the first Eagle to record an INT in 4+ consecutive games since Bill Bradley in 1972.

IF GARDNER-JOHNSON RECORDS AN INT THIS WEEK, HE WILL BECOME THE FIRST NFL SAFETY TO RECORD AN INT IN 5 STRAIGHT GAMES SINCE REGGIE NELSON & KURT COLEMAN IN 2015 (FIRST EAGLE TO DO SO SINCE THE 1970 MERGER)

- Philadelphia is aiming to extend its winning streak to 9 consecutive games, which would tie a franchise record (also 1960, 2003 and 2017). In addition, the Eagles would clinch their 18th winning season under Jeffrey Lurie (5th-most in NFL since 1995).
- Philadelphia can become just the second team in NFL history to win the turnover battle in each of the first 9 games of a season, joining the 1958 Baltimore Colts (led by Johnny Unitas).
