PHILADELPHIA EAGLES at INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

PHILADELPHIA DEFEATS INDIANAPOLIS 17-16, IMPROVES TO 9-1

- Philadelphia is 9-1 for the 6th time in franchise history (also 1949, 1960, 1980, 2004 and 2017).
- The Eagles overcame a 10-point deficit entering the fourth quarter, taking the lead with 1:20 remaining in the game.
 - The comeback win marked the team's first victory after trailing by 10+ points entering the fourth quarter since 12/20/10 against the New York Giants.
- **Jalen Hurts** completed 18-of-25 (72.0%) attempts for 190 yards, 1 TD and a 107.1 passer rating, while also rushing for 86 yards and 1 TD on 16 carries.
 - Hurts' 2 total TDs extends his streak to 6 consecutive games with 2 or more total TDs, marking a career best. Hurts entered Week 11 with the 3rd-longest active streak in the NFL, trailing **Joe Burrow** (7) and **Patrick Mahomes** (6).

POST-GAME NOTES

- **Jake Elliott** put the Eagles on the board following a 15 play, 54-yard drive that resulted in a 22-yard FG, making the score 3-7.
- Philadelphia cut the deficit to 10-13 in the fourth quarter when **Jalen Hurts** connected with **Quez Watkins** on a 22-yard TD pass, completing a 5-play, 60-yard scoring drive after a missed 50-yard FG attempt by Colts K **Chase McLaughlin**. Hurts posted 2 plays of 20+ yards (23-yard scramble and 22-yard TD pass) over the span of 3 plays to lead the Eagles to their first TD of the game.
 - Watkins' 2nd receiving TD of the season marks a new career high.
- On the series following Philadelphia's TD that made it a 3-point game, **Marcus Epps** forced a fumble against Colts RB **Jonathan Taylor** that was recovered by **T.J. Edwards** at the PHI 43. The takeaway marked Epps' 1st career forced fumble and Edwards' 2nd career fumble recovery.
- **Haason Reddick** sacked Colts QB **Matt Ryan** to force a Colts FG with 4:41 remaining in the fourth quarter.
 - The sack moved Reddick's season sack total to 7.5, which leads all Eagles defenders this season.
- **Jalen Hurts** tied the game on a 7-yard TD run with 1:20 remaining in the game. **Jake Elliott** gave the Eagles a 17-16 lead after connecting on the PAT.
- **Brandon Graham** sacked Colts QB **Matt Ryan** on third down to force the Colts into a fourth-and-long situation, where they were unable to convert.
 - The sack brings Graham's career total to 63.0, which ranks as the 4th-most sacks in franchise history.

KELCE & COX IN THE RECORD BOOKS

- **Jason Kelce** appeared in his 169th career regular-season game, which ties **Chuck Bednarik** (169, 1949-62) for the most games played by an offensive lineman in Eagles history.
 - Kelce is tied for 6th overall in team history (t-3rd among offensive players), behind **David Akers** (188, 1999-2010), **Brian Dawkins** (183, 1996-2008), **Harold Carmichael** (180, 1971-83), **Brent Celek** (175, 2007-17), and **Brandon Graham** (171, 2010-present).
- Kelce made his 132nd consecutive regular-season start, which is the longest active streak among NFL centers (2nd-longest streak by any NFL player, trailing only **Jake Matthews** – 138).

- Kelce's streak is the longest by any NFL center since **Casey Wiegman** from 2001-11 (175). It is also the 3rd-longest streak by any player in franchise history, trailing only **Jon Runyan** (144, 2000-08) and **Herman Edwards** (135, 1977-85).
- **Fletcher Cox** tied **Tra Thomas** (166, 1998-2008) for the 8th-most games played in team history. His 166 games are the 4th-most ever by an Eagles defensive player, behind **Brian Dawkins** (183, 1996-2008), **Brandon Graham** (171, 2010-present), and **Chuck Bednarik** (169, 1949-62).
