Dedicated NIL resources to support the organization
- His grandfather, Stephen R. Covey, wrote the best-selling book, "The 7 Habits of Highly Successful People," which sold more than 40 million copies worldwide ... Considers his grandfather one of his biggest influences and strives to exemplify the principles in his book
- ▶ His father, brother and uncle each played football at BYU ... Grew up only two miles from BYU's LaVell Edwards Stadium, where almost his entire family owned season tickets ... Generations of relatives attended BYU, but that trend changed with a scholarship offer from Utah ... BYU did offer, but it came late in the process, so his family then converted to the rivals of their once-beloved school ... Notably, his grandfather, Stephen R. Covey, earned degrees from BYU, Utah and Harvard
- A devout member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, embarked on a mission trip in Chile after a promising start to his football career ... Reflects on the mission as the best two years of his life ... Returned two years later and continued to have success
