- ▶ Hosts a youth football camp at West Limestone (AL) High School, his alma mater, which welcomed over 100 participants in its first year
- ▶ Is from Athens, AL, which also is the hometown of **Philip Rivers** ... Attended school in Lester, AL, whose population is roughly 130

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ A member of the Eagles' Super Bowl LVII roster in 2022 ... One of just three UDFA's to make Philadelphia's roster out of training camp

2024 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Recorded 10 tackles (4 solo) and 1 INT in the 26-18 win over Washington (11/14/24) ... Intercepted Commanders QB **Jayden Daniels** with 4:58 remaining in the fourth quarter
- ▶ Picked off Saints QB **Derek Carr** with :55 remaining in the fourth quarter to seal Philadelphia's 15-12 victory over New Orleans (9/22/24)
- ▶ Intercepted Packers QB **Jordan Love** with 6:15 remaining in the third quarter of a 34-29 win vs. Green Bay (9/6/24) ... The INT helped Philadelphia secure a lead they would not surrender

2023 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Led the defense with career highs in tackles (108) and INTs (3) ... Also registered a career-high 11 PDs with 2 TFLs and 1 FR ... His 108 tackles were the most by an Eagles safety since 1994 ... One of six NFL players to post 100+ tackles, 10+ PDs and 3+ INTs, joining **Jessie Bates**, **Julian Love**, **Xavier McKinney**, **Fred Warner** and **Antoine Winfield Jr.**
- ▶ Picked off QB **Tyrod Taylor** at N.Y. Giants (1/7/24)
- ▶ Made a career-high-tying 11 tackles vs. Arizona (12/31/23)
- ▶ Logged 8 tackles and 1 INT in the 38-31 win at Washington (10/29/23)

- ▶ Registered 7 tackles and 1 INT in the 25-11 win at Tampa Bay (9/25/23)
- ... Picked off Buccaneers QB **Baker Mayfield** in the second quarter
- ▶ Had a career-high 11 tackles in the win at New England (9/10/23)

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Played collegiately at Middle Tennessee State (2017-21), where he was a five-year starter and three-year captain ... Is the Blue Raiders' all-time leader with 419 tackles (265 solo) ... Also registered 26.5 TFLs, 19 PDs, 9 INTs, 4 FRs, 3 FFs and 3.0 sacks in 55 career games (50 starts)
- ▶ Voted first-team All-Conference USA following the 2021 season, when he posted career highs with 110 tackles (75 solo), 10 TFLs and 8 PDs along with 3 FRs (1 TD), 2 FFs, 1 INT and 1.0 sack
- ▶ Totaled 58 tackles (40 solo), 3 PDs, 2 INTs, 1 FF and 1 FR en route to second-team All-C-USA honors in 2019 ... Recorded 2 blocked kicks (1 FG, 1 PAT), which tied for the most in the nation
- ▶ Garnered first-team All-C-USA accolades in 2018 after notching 107 tackles (69 solo), 8 TFLs, 7 PDs and 4 INTs (1 TD)
