- Represented the A.J. Brown Foundation through the NFL's *My Cause My Cleats* campaign in 2023 ... The foundation's vision is to inspire young people and empower young individuals to thrive and positively impact their communities
- Considers **Jalen Hurts** one of his best friends ... Both members of the 2016 high school recruiting cycle, Hurts attempted to bring Brown to Alabama, but he opted to play at Ole Miss instead ... The two stayed in contact ever since and have developed a strong bond
- Opened up about his battle with depression in a video he posted on social media during the 2021 season ... "I wanted to encourage others to seek help whenever they are down. I didn't take into consideration what depression really was. ... Us as men, our feelings aren't too much cared about. Get things off your chest. It's okay to talk to someone. You have to take care of your brain just like you take care of your body."
- Represented Open Door Abuse Awareness & Prevention through the NFL's *My Cause My Cleats* campaign in 2022 ... The organization aims to prevent domestic violence and abuse among youth
- A standout high school baseball player who was selected by the San Diego Padres as an outfielder in the 19th round (564th overall) of the 2016 MLB Draft ... Participated in the Padres' extended spring training during the summers of 2016, 2017 and 2018

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Earned **All-Pro** second team recognition from the *Associated Press* and was voted to his third **Pro Bowl** in 2023 after recording 1,456 receiving yards on 106 catches (13.8 avg) with 7 TDs and setting a new NFL record with 6 consecutive games of 125+ receiving yards
- Named an *Associated Press* second-team **All-Pro** and earned his second career **Pro Bowl** honor in 2022, when the Eagles made an appearance in Super Bowl LVII ... Broke a 38-year, single-season team record in receiving yards (1,496), surpassing **Mike Quick** in 1983 (1,409)
- Joined **DeVonta Smith** (1,196) in becoming the first Eagles combo to each produce 1,000+ receiving yards in the same season in 2022
- Logged 96 yards and 1 TD on 6 receptions (16.0 avg.) vs. Kansas City in Super Bowl LVII on 2/12/23 ... His 45-yard TD in the second quarter marked the longest TD catch in Eagles Super Bowl history
- Voted to his first career **Pro Bowl** following the 2020 season, when he posted 70 catches for 1,075 yards and 11 TDs with the Titans
- Selected to the 2019 PFWA **All-Rookie** Team after becoming the third rookie in Tennessee history with 1,000+ receiving yards

NOTES TO KNOW

- Recorded 6 consecutive games with 125+ receiving yards during the 2023 season, setting a new NFL record for most consecutive games with 125+ receiving yards, surpassing **Calvin Johnson** (5 Games, 2012) and **Pat Studstill** (5 Games, 1966)
- Is the first player in Eagles history to produce 1,200+ receiving yards in

- consecutive seasons (team-record 1,496 receiving yards in 2022)
- ▶ Leads the NFL with a 15.7 receiving average since entering the league in 2019 (min. 275 receptions) ... Also ranks 1st in the NFL in 50+ yard receptions (14) in that span

2023 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Totaled 1,456 receiving yards and 106 receptions (Eagles single-season WR reception record) with 7 TDs to earn his third **Pro Bowl** honor ... Brown became the first player in NFL history to record 6 consecutive games of 125+ receiving yards ... He also finished 5th in the NFL in receiving
- ▶ Posted 130 yards on 8 receptions (16.3 avg) and 2 TDs in the victory at Washington (10/29/23) ... With a 16-yard reception in the fourth quarter, Brown became the first player in NFL history to record 6 consecutive games with 125+ receiving yards
- ▶ Awarded **October's NFC Offensive Player of the Month** after leading the NFL in receiving yards and receiving average (min. 25 receptions), recording 700 yards on 40 receptions (17.5 avg) and catching 5 TD ... Posted 125+ receiving yards in all 5 contests during the month of October, becoming the first Eagle to record 5 consecutive games of 125+ receiving yards
- ▶ Earned **NFC Offensive Player of the Week** after recording 137 yards on 13 catches (13.7 avg) in the victory vs Miami (10/22/23) ... In the 3rd quarter, Brown caught a short pass and turned it into a 14-yard touchdown that gave Philadelphia an insurmountable lead
- ▶ Led the Eagles with 127 yards on 6 receptions (21.2 avg.) in the 23-14 win at L.A. Rams (10/8/23) ... His 36-yard catch followed by back-to-back penalties drawn in the final series of the first half helped set up a TD that gave the Eagles a lead they did not surrender ... Became the second player in team history to register 125+ receiving yards in three consecutive games, joining **Harold Jackson** (9/17/72-10/2/72)
- ▶ Totaled 175 yards and 2 TDs on 9 receptions (19.4 avg.) in the 34-31 OT victory vs. Washington (10/1/23) ... Caught a season-long, 59-yard TD pass in the third quarter to give Philadelphia a lead ... Became the first Eagle to produce 175+ receiving yards and 2 TDs in a game since **Jeremy Maclin** on 10/26/14 at Arizona (187 yards, 2 TDs)
- ▶ Tallied 131 yards on 9 receptions (14.6 avg.) in the 25-11 victory at Tampa Bay (9/25/23) ... His 73 YAC marked his most in a game since 10/25/20 vs. Pittsburgh with Tennessee (career-high 96 YAC)



2022 SEASON - EAGLES

- Totaled 1,496 yards and 11 TDs on 88 catches (17.0 avg.) en route to *Associated Press* second-team **All-Pro** and **Pro Bowl** accolades in his first season with the Eagles ... Established a club record in receiving yards, snapping a 38-year mark set by **Mike Quick** in 1983 (1,409) ... Also teamed up with **DeVonta Smith** (1,196) to become the first ever 1,000+ receiving yard duo in single-season franchise history
- Ranked 1st in the NFL with 18 receptions of 25+ yards ... Finished 2nd in yards per catch (17.0), trailing only **Jaylen Waddle** (18.1) ... Had the 2nd-most YAC (548) among WRs, behind **Justin Jefferson** (623)
- Tied for the 3rd-most receiving TDs (career-high-tying 11) in the NFL, trailing only **Davante Adams** (14) and **Travis Kelce** (12) ... Owned the 4th-most receiving yards (career-high 1,496) in the NFL, behind **Justin Jefferson** (1,809), **Tyreek Hill** (1,710) and **Adams** (1,516)
- Caught 6 passes for 96 yards (16.0 avg.) against Kansas City in Super Bowl LVII (2/12/23), including the longest TD reception (45) in Eagles Super Bowl history ... In the regular season, set a career-high with 181 yards on 9 catches in the win at Chicago (12/18/22)

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- Played collegiately at Ole Miss, where he left as the program's all-time leading receiver with 2,984 yards ... Also finished his Rebels career 3rd in school history in receptions (189) and 5th in receiving TDs (19)
- Earned All-America and first-team All-SEC honors as a junior in 2018, when he set single-season school records in yards (1,320) and receptions (85) and combined for 6 TDs ... Led the conference and ranked in the top 10 nationally in yards per game (110.0) and catches
- Received All-America and All-SEC recognition as a sophomore in 2017 after tying Ole Miss' single-season record for TDs (11)
