BIRDSEED

- ▶ His career was boosted by former NFL RB **Maurice Jones-Drew**, who coached a travel 7-on-7 team called KT Prep in Concord, CA ... After receiving zero recruiting stars and no offers, he was convinced by his friends to try out and was selected by Jones-Drew as one of two QBs on the roster ... He impressed with KT Prep, which led Jones-Drew to contact Nevada and tell them Strong could change their program ... Jones-Drew was the first person to really tell him he had a shot

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Played collegiately at Nevada (2018-21), where he started three years and twice earned first-team all-conference recognition and Mountain West Offensive Player of the Year honors ... Completed 852-of-1,251 (68.1%) attempts for 9,368 yards, 74 TDs, 19 INTs and a 147.5 passer efficiency rating in 32 games (31 starts) ... Finished with the 2nd-most passing TDs in school history, behind **Colin Kaepernick** (82, 2007-10) ... Also produced the 4th-most passing yards by a Nevada QB
- ▶ Threw for 4,175 yards, 36 TDs, 8 INTs and a 157.0 efficiency rating on 366-of-522 (70.1%) passing as a junior in 2021 ... Led the conference in TD passes (program record) and yards (2nd-most in Nevada history) ... Named to the Davey O'Brien Quarterback Class of 2021 and was a semifinalist for the Unitas Golden Arm Award and Manning Award
- ▶ As a sophomore in 2020, completed 249-of-355 (70.1%) passes for 2,858 yards, 27 TDs, 4 INTs and a 160.6 efficiency rating ... Paced the Mountain West in passing yards, TDs and completion percentage and ranked 2nd in the FBS in completions per game (27.7)

PERSONAL

- ▶ Prepped at Wood (CA) High School, where he was a two-sport athlete in football and basketball ... Did not play as a senior due to injury ... As a junior, completed 184-of-266 (69.2%) passes for 2,732 yards, 26 TDs and 4 INTs in 10 contests ... Averaged 18.1 points, 12.8 rebounds and 2.8 assists with 21 double-doubles as a junior in basketball
- ▶ Is the son of Chris and Kristine Strong ... Chris served as the principal at Wood High School for many years and coached multiple sports
- ▶ Majored in management during his time at Nevada
