BIRDSEED

- Grew up in a family that has farmed cattle, corn, hay, soybeans and more for over 100 years ... His great grandfather established Jurgens Farms in the small town of Pickrell, NE in 1907 ... Attributes his hard work, attention to detail, and humility to being raised on a farm
- ▶ Built his own beef jerky business with the assistance of family and friends ... Originally a product of NIL, "Jurgy," whose title comes from Jurgens' nickname, is a proud distributor of Midwest beef jerky that comes in five different flavors original, hot honey, cracked pepper, mango habanero and teriyaki and sells apparel on its site (jurgy.co) ... Jurgens serves as the "Chief Beef Officer" of the company
- Supported the Team Jack Foundation through the NFL's My Cause My Cleats campaign in 2024 ... The organization works to fund impactful childhood brain cancer research and raise national awareness ... Has also represented the Eagles Autism Foundation through MCMC

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- ► Garnered **Pro Bowl** accolades following his first season as the team's starting center in 2024 ... Became the youngest Eagles center to earn Pro Bowl recognition since **Ken Farragut** at 25 years old in 1953
- ▶ Blocked for a **Super Bowl LIX**-winning OL that helped **Saquon Barkley** (2,005) become just the ninth player in NFL history to join the 2,000+ yard rushing club in 2024 ... Barkley established a league record with 2,504 rushing yards in the regular season and playoffs ... The Eagles totaled the most combined rushing yards (3,866) in NFL history
- ▶ A member of the Eagles' Super Bowl LVII roster in 2022

2024 SEASON - EAGLES

- Earned his first career Pro Bowl after taking over as the club's starting center ... At 25 years old, became the youngest Eagles center to produce a Pro Bowl campaign since Ken Farragut in 1953 (also 25)
- ▶ Contributed to the Eagles' **Super Bowl LIX**-winning OL that paved the way for **Saquon Barkley**, who finished as the NFL's rushing champion with 2,005 yards ... Barkley, who became the ninth all-time member of the league's 2,000+ yard rushing club, set an NFL record with 2,504 rushing yards in the regular season and playoffs ... Philadelphia also combined for the most rushing yards (3,866) in league history
- ▶ Helped the Eagles set a team record in passer rating (103.4)



COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

▶ Started 31 of 32 career games at Nebraska (2018-21) ... Earned All-Big Ten accolades from the league's coaches and media after his junior season in 2021 ... Became the first Huskers freshman (true or redshirt) to start a game at center since 1972 ... Originally recruited as a TE and appeared in one game at the position
