- ▶ Studied mechanical engineering at Georgia and is interested in prosthetics ... His passion for the field stems from many visits to Veterans Affairs with his mother, who served in the military ... Felt at a young age that he wanted to improve the lives of injured veterans
- ▶ Maintained a 3.55 GPA in the mechanical engineering program during his time at Georgia ... During the 2023 offseason, returned to school to continue working toward finishing his degree requirements ... Would consider pursuing pre-med studies following his NFL career
- ▶ Was roommates with **Nolan Smith** at Georgia

- ▶ During Weeks 6-18, ranked 2nd among NFL LBs in *Pro Football Focus* defensive grade (88.3), trailing only **Zack Baun** (91.5) in that span
 - ▶ Made 10 tackles with 1 FF in the 27-13 win vs. Pittsburgh (12/15/24)
 - ▶ Intercepted Jaguars QB **Trevor Lawrence** in the end zone with 1:38 left in regulation to seal the 28-23 victory vs. Jacksonville (11/3/24)
 - ▶ Posted 11 tackles, 4 QB hits, 3 pressures and a career-high 2.0 sacks against QB **Daniel Jones** in the 28-3 win at N.Y. Giants (10/20/24)

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Played collegiately at Georgia (2019-21), where he totaled 168 tackles (89 solo), 13.5 TFLs, 10 PDs, 7.5 sacks, 3 FFs and 2 INTs in 39 career games (25 starts) ... A team captain who helped guide the Bulldogs to the CFP National Championship during the 2021 campaign
- ▶ Voted the recipient of the 2021 Butkus Award (nation’s best LB) along with first-team All-SEC honors ... Selected as the SEC Defensive Player of the Year by *Pro Football Focus* and was a semifinalist for the 2021 Chuck Bednarik Award, which recognizes the best defensive player in college football ... Finished his junior campaign with 72 tackles (career high), 10.5 TFLs (team high), 8 PDs, 6.0 sacks, 2 INTs and 2 FFs
- ▶ Named a semifinalist for the Butkus Award as a sophomore in 2020, leading Georgia in tackles (71) and producing 1.5 sacks
