Marcus Brady was hired as the Philadelphia Eagles’ senior offensive assistant during the 2023 offseason. He comes to Philadelphia with 15 years of coaching experience, including six seasons working in the NFL.

Prior to joining the Eagles’ staff, Brady spent five seasons with the Indianapolis Colts, serving as the offensive coordinator (2021-22), quarterbacks coach (2019-20) and assistant quarterbacks coach (2018). While he was at Indianapolis, Brady coached with **Nick Sirianni**, who was the Colts’ offensive coordinator from 2018-20. He then replaced Sirianni in 2021.

In his first year as offensive coordinator, Brady directed Indianapolis to one of the top rushing attacks in the league, as the Colts finished second in the NFL in rushing yards per game (149.4) and yards per carry (5.1) and tied for the fifth-most rushing touchdowns (22). Under Brady’s guidance, running back **Jonathan Taylor** received *Associated Press* first-team All-Pro recognition and was named to his first career Pro Bowl after leading the league with team records in rushing yards (1,811) and touchdowns (18).

In 2020, Brady guided **Philip Rivers** to the eighth-best completion percentage (68.0 pct.) and 10th-most passing yards (4,169) in the NFL as Indianapolis’ quarterbacks coach. In 2018, while serving as the assistant quarterbacks coach, he helped **Andrew Luck** earn *AP* NFL Comeback Player of the Year as well as Pro Bowl honors after throwing for the second-most passing touchdowns (39) and fifth-most passing yards (4,593) in the league.

Brady spent the first nine years of his coaching career in the Canadian Football League. He was the Toronto Argonauts’ offensive coordinator from 2013-17 and helped guide the team to the 2017 Grey Cup.

In 2012, Brady coordinated the Montreal Alouettes’ offense after mentoring the wideouts from 2009-11. Before his transition to coaching, Brady spent seven seasons (2002-08) playing quarterback in the CFL.

A native of San Diego, CA, Brady attended Cal State Northridge where he obtained a degree in finance while playing quarterback for the Matadors. He and his wife, Sherrie, have two children: Saliyah and Aaden.
