BIRDSEED

- Created the Nolan Smith Foundation to capitalize on the platform that sports provide to support and inspire communities in need ... Hosts an annual youth football camp called “Pups Day Out” in his hometown, providing hands-on training of technique for children to develop as football players while gaining valuable life lessons ... The foundation is also involved in community bicycle drives, golf fundraisers and providing meals to the homeless, among other charitable endeavors
- Wears No. 3 as a tribute to his mother, Chakeima Bigham ... Chakeima also wore the number playing high school sports in Savannah, GA
- Posted historic figures at the 2023 NFL Combine, including a 4.39 40-yard dash and a 41.5-inch vertical ... Each of those led all DL at the Combine ... Became the heaviest player in Combine history to log a sub-4.4 40-yard dash along with a 40+ inch vertical
- Prepped at Calvary Day School (Savannah, GA) before transferring to IMG Academy (Bradenton, FL) for his final two years of high school ... Rated a top-five player nationally across recruiting platforms

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Totaled 4.0 sacks during Philadelphia’s **Super Bowl LIX**-winning playoff run in 2024, marking the most by an Eagle in a single postseason

NOTES TO KNOW

- His 4.5 career sacks in the playoffs are the 3rd-most in Eagles postseason history, behind **Brandon Graham** (5.5) and **Josh Sweat** (5.0)

2025 SEASON - EAGLES

- Appeared in 12 games (12 starts), totaling 31 tackles (15 solo), 3.0 sacks and 1 FF in 451 defensive snaps

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ A two-time CFP National Champion (2021, '22) at Georgia (2019-22) ... During his Bulldogs career, registered 114 tackles (66 solo), 21 TFLs, 11.5 sacks, 4 PDs, 3 FFs, 1 FR and 1 INT in 36 games (22 starts)
- ▶ As a senior in 2022, led Georgia with 16 hurries through eight games (all starts) before sustaining a season-ending injury ... Finished with 18 tackles (14 solo), 7 TFLs, 3.0 sacks and 1 PD ... Named to preseason watch lists for the Outland Trophy (nation’s top interior lineman) and Bronko Nagurski Trophy (nation’s top defender) ... Additionally was a second-team preseason All-America selection by *Athlon Sports*
- ▶ Totaled 56 tackles (31 solo), 9 TFLs, 3.5 sacks, 3 FFs, 2 PDs and 1 FR over 14 games (all starts) during his junior campaign in 2021 ... Earned SEC Co-Defensive Player of the Week twice, including when he produced a FF, FR and INT in that span of 39 seconds vs. Florida
