## BIRDSEED

- ▶ An outstanding athlete at Apopka (FL) High School, which is also the alma mater of Pro Football Hall of Fame DT **Warren Sapp** ... Played at multiple positions throughout his high school career, including DT, TE, FB and punter ... Booted a 60+ yard punt in the state championship game ... In addition to football, lettered in basketball and competed in heavyweight lifting competitions ... In middle school, saw action at RB, CB, WR and QB, throwing a 70+ yard TD pass in an AAU game
- ▶ During his pre-draft visit with the Eagles, served **Nick Sirianni** a quick 'H' competing in a game of 'HORSE' by delivering a flat-footed windmill dunk on his first try, leaving the head coach in disbelief ... Rumored to have been able to dunk as early as 5th grade, Carter previously went viral in high school after throwing down a windmill dunk in a game
- ▶ Inspired to give back to his community in Apopka, organized his first youth football camp with the help of his mother in 2022 ... Grew up going to camps, which helped him become the player he is today

## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Was selected to his second straight **Pro Bowl** in 2025 after supporting a defense that allowed the fewest passing TDs (14) in the NFL and the lowest completion percentage (56.8%) in the league
- ▶ Earned second-team **All-Pro** and **Pro Bowl** honors during the Eagles' **Super Bowl LIX**-winning campaign in 2024 ... Led the defense in pressures (45), QB hits (16) and TFLs (12) ... Became the youngest DT (23 years old) in franchise history to garner Pro Bowl accolades
- ▶ Voted to the PFWA **All-Rookie** Team in 2023 ... Logged the most sacks (6.0) by an Eagles rookie since **Derrick Burgess** in 2001 (6.0)

## 2025 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Earned his second career **Pro Bowl** nod after appearing in 11 games (11 starts), totaling 33 tackles (21 solo), 29 pressures, 12 QB hits, 7 PDs, 4 TFLs and 3.0 sacks ... Tied with **Jordan Davis** (6) for the 2nd-most batted

- ▶ Blocked a 36-yard Rams **Joshua Karty** FG with 8:26 remaining in the fourth quarter to help the Eagles orchestrate a game winning drive in the 33-26 win vs. Los Angeles (9/21/25)

**2024 SEASON - EAGLES**

- ▶ Received second-team **All-Pro** and **Pro Bowl** recognition for the first time in his career after leading Philadelphia's **Super Bowl LIX**-winning defense in pressures (45), QB hits (16) and TFLs (12) ... At 23 years old, became the youngest Eagles DT to produce a Pro Bowl season ... Also tallied a career-high 42 tackles with 5 PDs, 4.5 sacks and 2 FFs
- ▶ Ranked 4th among interior DL in *Pro Football Focus* pass-rush grade (81.5), behind **Chris Jones** (91.0), **Cameron Heyward** (87.2) and **Jeffery Simmons** (81.6) in that category (min. 400 pass-rush snaps)
- ▶ Produced a career-high-tying 2.0 sacks against Rams QB **Matthew Stafford** with 6 pressures, 5 tackles, 2 PDs and 1 FF in the 28-22 victory vs. L.A. Rams in the NFC Divisional Playoff (1/19/25) ... Also sacked Giants QB **Daniel Jones** twice in the 28-3 win at New York (10/20/24)

**COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS**

- ▶ A two-time CFP National Champion at Georgia (2021, '22), where he played three seasons (2020-22) ... Totaled 83 tackles (44 solo), 18.5 TFLs, 6.0 sacks, 4 PDs and 2 FFs in 38 career games (13 starts)
- ▶ Received first-team All-America honors and was voted first-team All-SEC as a junior in 2022 ... Named a finalist for the Rotary Lombardi Award (nation's top lineman) ... Finished the season with 32 tackles (16 solo), 7 TFLs, 3.0 sacks, 3 PDs and 2 FFs in 13 games (nine starts)
