BIRDSEED

- ▶ Previously selected as the Giants’ Walter Payton NFL Man of the Year nominee in 2022 and 2023 ... The award is considered the NFL’s most prestigious honor and recognizes players who have demonstrated excellence on the field and a passion to impact the lives of others
- ▶ Created the Michael Ann and Saquon Barkley Hope Foundation ... The group’s mission is to support the goals and dreams of youth through scholarships, educational assistance and athletics guidance
- ▶ Established the Saquon Barkley Center of Excellence with St. Luke’s University Health Network in Whitehall, PA, to bring opportunities to underserved youth with a focus on physical activity and academics
- ▶ Comes from a family with a boxing history ... His father, Alibay, was an amateur boxer, while his great uncle, Iran Barkley, was a professional boxer and world champion in three different weight divisions

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Named the **NFL Offensive Player of the Year** and was recognized as an NFL MVP finalist by the *Associated Press* in 2024 ... Rushed for a franchise-record 2,005 yards, becoming just the ninth member of the league’s 2,000+ yard rushing club (8th-most rushing yards in NFL history) ... Also earned first-team **All-Pro** and **Pro Bowl** honors and completed his historic season with a **Super Bowl LIX** victory ... Finished as the third rushing champion to win a Super Bowl in the same season, joining **Terrell Davis** (1998) and **Emmitt Smith** (1992, ’93, ’95)
- ▶ Established an NFL record with 2,504 rushing yards in the regular season and playoffs in 2024, breaking the previous mark set by **Terrell Davis** in 1998 (2,476) ... Also became the first player in history to pro-

- ▶ duce seven 60+ yard rushing TDs in a season (including playoffs)
- ▶ Registered the most rushing yards (255) and scrimmage yards (302) in Eagles single-game history on 11/24/24 at L.A. Rams ... Set the team playoff record for rushing yards (205) on 1/19/25 vs. L.A. Rams
- ▶ Voted to his second **Pro Bowl** and was selected a finalist for AP NFL Comeback Player of the Year with the Giants following the 2022 campaign, when he rushed for 1,312 yards and 10 TDs on 295 carries
- ▶ Honored as the AP NFL Offensive Rookie of the Year and earned **Pro Bowl** and PFWA **All-Rookie** accolades after the 2018 season, when he produced Giants rookie records with 1,307 rushing yards (2nd in the NFL), 91 receptions and 15 total TDs (11 rushing, 4 receiving)

NOTES TO KNOW

- ▶ Ranks 2nd in the NFL with 88.9 rushing yards per game dating back to 2022 (min. 45 games), behind only **Derrick Henry** (90.6) ... Has registered the 2nd-most rushing yards (4,798) overall during that stretch, trailing only Henry (5,136)
- ▶ Is 5th among NFL RBs with 33 rushing TDs since 2022, behind **Derrick Henry** (47), **Josh Jacobs** (43), **David Montgomery** (35) and **Jonathan Taylor** (34) ... Also leads the NFL with 9 rushing TDs of 60+ yards since 2018

2025 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Totaled a season-high 150 yards on 14 carries (10.7 avg.) with 1 TD and added 24 yards and 1 receiving TD on 4 receptions in the 38-20 win vs. N.Y. Giants (10/26/25)

2024 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Recognized as the Associated Press **NFL Offensive Player of the Year** after leading the NFL with a franchise-record 2,005 rushing yards and tallying 13 rushing TDs on a league-high 345 attempts ... Became just the ninth all-time member of the 2,000+ yard rushing club (8th-most rushing yards in NFL history) ... Additionally honored as an AP NFL MVP finalist and collected first-team **All-Pro** and **Pro Bowl** accolades
- ▶ Finished his historic campaign with a **Super Bowl LIX** victory ... Became only the third rushing champion to win a Super Bowl in the same season, joining **Terrell Davis** (1998) and **Emmitt Smith** (1992, '93, '95)
- ▶ Produced the most combined rushing yards (2,504) in NFL history, in-

cluding a team-record 499 rushing yards in the playoffs ... Broke the previous mark set by **Terrell Davis** in 1998 (2,476) ... Also notched the most 60+ yard rushing TDs (seven) in history (including playoffs)

- ▶ Rushed for a team-playoff-record 205 yards with 2 TDs (both for 60+ yards) in the 28-22 victory vs. L.A. Rams in the NFC Divisional Round (1/19/25) ... His 205 rushing yards broke a 74-year mark set by **Steve Van Buren** in the 1949 NFL Championship (196 yards on 12/18/49 vs. L.A. Rams) ... His 78-yard, game-sealing score in the snow was the longest rushing TD in the fourth quarter of a postseason game since **Charlie Garner** with Oakland vs. N.Y. Jets on 1/12/02 (80 yards)
- ▶ Posted franchise records in rushing yards (255) and scrimmage yards (302) in the 37-20 win at L.A. Rams (11/24/24) ... Eclipsed prior team marks set by **LeSean McCoy** (217 rushing yards on 12/8/13 vs. Detroit) and **Duce Staley** (262 scrimmage yards on 9/3/00 vs. Dallas) ... Both were the 9th-highest totals in NFL history ... Became the first player to have multiple 70+ yard rushing TDs in a game since 2009
- ▶ Voted **NFC Offensive Player of the Month** for November after leading the league in rushing yards (626) and rushing TDs (5) ... Set an Eagles record with four **NFC Offensive Player of the Week** awards

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Played collegiately at Penn State (2015-17), finishing his time with 671 carries for 3,843 yards (5.7 avg.) and 43 TDs while catching 102 passes for 1,195 yards (11.7 avg.) with 8 TDs ... Amassed 5,538 total yards on 791 touches for averages of 7.0 yards per play and 145.7 yards per game ... Ended his career as the Nittany Lions’ all-time leader in all-purpose yards (5,538), total TDs (53) and rushing TDs (43) ... Additionally, his 318 points were the most ever by a Penn State non-kicker
- ▶ A two-time Big Ten Most Valuable Player (2016-17), Big Ten Offensive Player of the Year (2016-17), Big Ten Running Back of the Year (2016-17) and first-team All-Big Ten selection (2016-17) ... Received the Paul Hornung Award (nation’s most versatile player) and was a consensus All-America selection in 2017, when he rushed for 1,271 yards on 217 attempts (5.9 avg.) with 18 TDs, along with 2 kickoff return TDs
