- Co-founded the *Exciting Mics* podcast with Reed Blankenship in 2025
- Participated in numerous volunteer activities during his time at Iowa, including staffing Special Olympics events, working with Safe Haven of Iowa County, assisting CommUnity Crisis Services and more ... Voted a semifinalist for the Lott IMPACT Trophy, which is awarded to a student-athlete who makes the biggest impact on and off the field
- Turned in a legendary football career at OA-BCIG (IA) High School as a QB and DB ... Set school career records in passing yards, passing TDs, completions and receiving TDs, in addition to single-season marks in passing yards, receptions, receiving yards and total yards ... Won back-to-back state championships as a junior and senior ... Scored the game-winning TD in the final minute of the state title game as a senior after his younger brother, Beckett, recovered a fumble on a kickoff
- Also lettered in basketball, baseball, and track at OA-BCIG ... Won the long jump and 100-meter dash state championships as a senior ... His 1,832 career points in basketball ranked just 58 points behind Vikings TE T.J. Hockenson on Iowa's all-time high school scoring list

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Was selected to his first career **Pro Bowl** in 2025 after assisting a defense that allowed a league-fewest 16 passing TDs
- A key contributor of Philadelphia's **Super Bowl LIX**-winning team in 2024 ... Recorded a 38-yard INT-TD in **Super Bowl LIX** against Kansas City, becoming the youngest player (22) in NFL history to do so
- Finished as an *Associated Press* NFL Defensive Rookie of the Year finalist in 2024 ... Didn't allow a TD the entire season and ranked 3rd among NFL CBs in PFF defensive grade (82.7) (min. 400 snaps)


2025 SEASON - EAGLES

- Played in 16 games (16 starts), recording 85 tackles (58 solo), 16 PDs, 4 TFLs and 2 INTs en route to earning first-team **All-Pro** honors and a **Pro Bowl** selection ... Joined **Quinyon Mitchell** as the first Eagle CBs to be voted first-team All-Pro since **Lito Sheppard** in 2004

- ▶ Intercepted Lions QB **Jared Goff** with 11:18 remaining in the first quarter and returned it 21 yards to set up a **Jake Elliott** field goal in the 16-9 win vs. Detroit (11/16/25)

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Played collegiately at Iowa (2021-23), where he recorded 120 tackles (85 solo) with 20 PDs and 7 INTs (3 TDs) in 30 games (24 starts) ... Also returned 31 punts for 406 yards (13.1 avg.) and 1 TD in his career
- ▶ Earned unanimous consensus All-America honors and was voted a finalist for the Bronko Nagurski (nation's best defensive player) and Jim Thorpe (nation's best DB) Awards in 2023 ... Also recognized as the Big Ten Defensive Back of the Year ... Registered 41 tackles (26 solo) with 2 INTs and returned 21 punts for 241 yards in 10 appearances
- ▶ Collected the first of two first-team All-Big Ten honors in his career in 2022, when he started all 13 games and produced 75 tackles (56 solo) with 8 PDs and 5 INTs, including a school-record 3 INT-TDs
