- ▶ Is the oldest son of Eagles Hall of Famer **Jeremiah Trotter**, who is remembered by fans as the "Axe Man" ... Trotter was selected by Philadelphia in the 3rd round (72nd overall) of the 1998 NFL Draft and went on to play 12 seasons, including eight years with the Eagles (1998-2001, 2004-06, 2009) ... Trotter finished his NFL career with 903 tackles (716 solo), 51 PDs, 12.5 sacks, 10 FFs, 9 INTs and 3 FRs in 147 games
 - ▶ Honors his late mother, Tammi, who passed away after a battle with breast cancer in February 2023, through the way he carries himself on and off the field ... Playing in the NFL was always a dream of his, but it was a dream of his mother's, too ... During her treatment, she would text him to share scripture and would call him to offer her support
 - ▶ His brother, Josiah, was selected by the Tampa Bay Buccaneers in the 2nd round (46th overall) of the 2026 NFL Draft
 - ▶ Attended St. Joseph's Prep in Philadelphia, where he helped lead the team to a No. 3 national ranking and won back-to-back 6A state championships ... Rated as the nation's No. 1 LB in his recruiting class

- ▶ In his rookie season, was a member of Philadelphia's **Super Bowl LIX**-winning team, playing a vital role on special teams

- to earn multiple All-America accolades since the 2000 campaign
- ▶ Earned first-team All-America honors from *ESPN* and *Sports Illustrated* and first-team All-ACC recognition while being named a Butkus Award (nation’s top LB) finalist in 2023 ... Became just the sixth Tiger to earn finalist status for the award ... Finished the season with a team-high 88 tackles, 15 TFLs, 6 PDs, 5.5 sacks, 2 FFs and 2 INTs (1 TD)
 - ▶ Started all 14 games during his sophomore campaign in 2022, totaling 92 tackles (74 solo), 13.5 TFLs, 6.5 sacks, 6 PDs, 2 INTs, 1 FF and 1 INT-TD ... Voted a second-team All-American by the *Associated Press* and helped the Tigers win the ACC Championship
