- ▶ Became the tallest WR selected in the NFL Draft in the last decade ... Was the tallest WR to ever participate at the NFL Combine and was measured to have the longest recorded wingspan (84.5 inches) ever by a WR prospect ... - ▶ Played in 16 games (four starts) during his rookie season, seeing 369 offensive snaps and adding 38 yards on 5 catches (7.6 avg) with 1 TD
- ▶ Caught his first career TD on a 5-yard pass from **Jalen Hurts** in Philadelphia’s 34-6 win over Dallas (11/10/24)

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Registered 102 receptions for 1,757 yards (17.2 avg.) and 8 TDs in 31 career games (26 starts) during stints with Arizona State (2020-21) and Florida State (2022-23) ... Started all 23 games he played for the Seminoles, catching 84 passes for 1,514 yards (18.0 avg.) and 7 TDs
- ▶ As a junior in 2023, started 10 contests and logged 617 yards on 41 receptions (15.0 avg.) with 2 TDs ... Voted third-team All-ACC and was selected by teammates for the Bob Crenshaw Award (offensive player with most heart) as well as the Bobby Bowden Leadership Award
- ▶ Earned ACC Newcomer of the Year honors and received second-team All-ACC accolades in 2022, when he totaled 897 yards and 5 TDs on 43 receptions (20.9 avg.) ... Led the conference and ranked 3rd nationally with 22 receptions of 20+ yards ... His 20.9 receiving average ranked 2nd in the ACC and 5th in the country ... Recorded a career-best 202 yards on 8 catches in the Cheez-It Bowl vs. Oklahoma (12/29/22)
