BIRDSEED

- ▶ Has supported the American Cancer Society in honor of his mother, Robin, who battled myeloma cancer, through the NFL's *My Cause My Cleats* campaign ... Also works with the league's *Crucial Catch* program to help fight cancer through early detection and risk reduction
- ▶ Prepped at Nazareth (PA) High School, where he was a three-sport athlete competing in football, basketball, and track ... Earned first-team All-USA Pennsylvania Football Team honors as a senior

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ A member of Philadelphia's **Super Bowl LIX**-winning team in 2024
- ▶ Originally selected by the Commanders with the 16th-overall pick in the 2022 NFL Draft ... Spent the first two seasons of his career in Washington, totaling 1,041 yards and 11 TDs on 84 receptions (12.4 avg.)

2025 SEASON - EAGLES

- ▶ Appeared in 17 contests (10 starts), posting 18 receptions for 262 yards (14.6 avg.) with 1 TD

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Played collegiately at Penn State (2018-21), appearing in 42 career games (38 starts) and totaling 183 catches (2nd-most in school history) for 2,757 yards (4th-most in school history) and 25 TDs (2nd-most in school history) ... Became the 10th player in program history to eclipse 2,000+ career receiving yards ... Posted the 2nd-most 100+ receiving yard games (11) in program history ... Set a school record for career punt return average (17.8)
- ▶ Voted a third-team All-American by the *Associated Press* and earned first-team All-Big Ten honors after producing 1,182 yards and 12 TDs on 91 receptions in 2021 ... Hauled in 3 TDs while establishing a Penn State receiving record with 242 yards vs. Maryland (11/6/21)
- ▶ Led the team in receiving with 884 yards in 2020, earning honorable mention All-America honors from *Phil Steele* ... Set a single-season mark at Penn State with a 24.6 yards per punt return average

- ▶ **2021** - Drafted by WAS in 1st round (16th overall) ... **8/22/24** - Acquired by PHI with 2025 5th-round draft pick from WAS in exchange for 2025 3rd-round draft pick and two 2025 7th-round draft picks
