

## POST-GAME NOTES PHILADELPHIA EAGLES vs. DENVER BRONCOS October 5, 2025

## **POST-GAME NOTES**

- The Eagles tied the game, 3-3, in the first quarter with a 31-yard FG by **Jake Elliott**, finishing a 12-play, 70-yard possession. Elliott has converted 5-of-5 FG (100%) attempts this season.
- Philadelphia claimed a 10-3 advantage in the second quarter with a 2-yard TD pass from **Jalen Hurts** to **Dallas Goedert**, finishing a 7-play, 90-yard series. Goedert has 1+ receiving TDs in three consecutive games, marking the longest streak by an Eagles TE since **Zach Ertz** in 2017 (four).
  - o Goedert's 4 TDs this season are tied for the 2nd-most of his career (5 in 2019).
    - Additionally, Goedert (3 catches for 19 yards and 1 TD) moved past Mike
       Quick (363, 1982-90) for the 9th-most receptions in franchise history today.
  - The score was set up by a season-long, 52-yard catch by **DeVonta Smith**, who
    moved Philadelphia to the DEN 26 with the 3rd-longest reception of his career. On
    the next play, a pass interference call that was drawn by **A.J. Brown** moved the
    offense to the PHI 2.
  - Before the offensive drive, Za'Darius Smith (70.5 career sacks) brought down Broncos QB Bo Nix for a 13-yard loss on third-and-8 that forced Denver out of FG range to punt.
- The Eagles increased their lead to 17-3 in the third quarter with a 47-yard TD catch by Saquon Barkley. Philadelphia needed just 4 plays to go 74 yards for a TD to open the second half.
  - Barkley's 47-yard TD was the longest receiving TD by an Eagle since **Darren Sproles**'
     73-yard TD on 9/25/16 vs. Pittsburgh. Furthermore, the play was Barkley's longest receiving TD since a 54-yard TD on 10/3/21 at New Orleans with N.Y. Giants.
- Jalen Hurts completed 23-of-38 (60.5%) attempts for a season-high 280 yards, 2 TDs, 0 INTs and a 100.8 passer rating. Hurts has recorded three straight games with 0 INTs and a 100+ rating.
- DeVonta Smith caught a season-high-tying 8 passes for a season-high 114 yards. The 114-yard performance was Smith's 11th career game with 100+ receiving yards (including playoffs).
