## BY THE NUMBERS

**.697**

Under Nick Sirianni's direction, the Eagles own the 2nd-best winning percentage (.697, 62-27) in the league since 2021 (including playoffs).

**40-2**

Since 2021, Philadelphia has a 40-2 (.952) record when winning the turnover battle, marking the 2nd-best win percentage in the NFL in those games.

**.750**

Philadelphia ranks 1st in the NFC in Interconference winning percentage (.750, 18-6) and rank 3rd overall in the NFL, behind only Kansas City and Buffalo.

**33-13**

The Eagles lead the league with a .717 (33-13) winning percentage in one-score games dating back to the 2021 campaign.

**75.9%**

Philadelphia leads the NFL with a 75.9% red zone TD efficiency, which marks the 4th-best figure by any team through 12 games over the last 10 seasons.

**56.4%**

The Eagles have limited opponents to the lowest completion percentage (56.4%) in the NFL and a league-best 48.8% mark on third and fourth downs.

## NOTES TO KNOW

### COAST TO COAST SUCCESS

- Since 2021, Philadelphia owns the NFL's highest winning percentage (.700, 28-12) on the road. The Eagles have a 9-3 (.750) record in their last 12 away contests dating back to last season.
