EAGLES DEFEAT PACKERS, 10-7, AT LAMBEAU FIELD TO IMPROVE TO 7-2

- With tonight's 10-7 victory at Green Bay, Philadelphia improved to 7-2 (.778) and remains the top seed in the conference entering Week 11. The Eagles have started 7-2 or better through nine games for the fourth consecutive season, marking the longest streak in team history.
 - According to *Elias Sports*, **Nick Sirianni** became the fifth NFL head coach (first in the Super Bowl Era) to start 7-2 or better in four of their first five seasons, joining Pro Football Hall of Famers **Paul Brown**, **Guy Chamberlin**, **George Halas** and **Don Shula**.
 - Philadelphia is tied for the 3rd-longest stretch of consecutive seasons with 7-2 starts or better since the 1970 NFL merger, trailing only the 2013-19 Patriots (seven with **Bill Belichick**) and 1971-75 Dolphins (five with **Don Shula**).
 - The Eagles are one of only six NFL teams with just two losses this season, joining Denver (8-2), Indianapolis (8-2), New England (8-2), L.A. Rams (7-2) and Seattle (7-2).
- **Nick Sirianni** (.714, 55-22) moved past **George Allen** (.712, 1966-77) for the 2nd-best winning percentage by a head coach in the Super Bowl Era, behind **John Madden** (.759, 1969-78). Sirianni's .714 winning percentage is the 5th-best mark in NFL history, trailing only **Guy Chamberlin** (.784, 1922-27), Madden, **Vince Lombardi** (.738, 1959-67 and '69) and **Ray Flaherty** (.720, 1936-42).
 - Sirianni (61-25) eclipsed **Dick Vermeil** (60-55) for the 3rd-most victories by an Eagles head coach (including playoffs), behind **Andy Reid** (150-111-1) and **Greasy Neale** (64-41-4).
- Under **Nick Sirianni**, Philadelphia has posted a 5-0 record after bye weeks (6-0 including the first-round bye in the 2022 playoffs). Since 2021, only four NFL teams have gone unbeaten after their bye weeks – Philadelphia (6-0), Baltimore (6-0), Buffalo (5-0) and Pittsburgh (5-0).
- Including playoffs, the Eagles are 10-0 against NFC North teams (4-0 vs. Green Bay) under **Nick Sirianni**. That is the most wins without a loss by a team against any division since 2021.
 - According to *Elias Sports*, Sirianni became the fourth head coach since the 1970 NFL merger to start their career with 10 consecutive wins against a single division (including playoffs). The other head coaches who accomplished that feat

are **Kevin Stefanski** (vs. AFC South), **Mike Holmgren** (vs. NFC South) and **Steve Mariucci** (vs. NFC West).

- Philadelphia owns the best road winning percentage (.718, 28-11) in the NFL since the 2021 campaign, earning victories in nine of its previous 11 away contests (4-1 in 2025).

POST-GAME NOTES

- **Jalyx Hunt** (back-to-back games with sacks for the first time in his career) brought down Packers QB **Jordan Love** for an 11-yard loss to force a third-and-20 and effectively end Green Bay's game-opening drive. The takedown was assisted by a pressure from **Jaelan Phillips**.
- **Braden Mann** booted a 66-yard punt in the second quarter, giving him a career-high 9 punts of 60+ yards this season. Mann had recorded just 6 punts of 60+ yards in 2023-24 combined.
 - Mann's 9 punts of 60+ yards this season are the most by any Eagles punter since 2000 (previously 6 punts of 60+ yards by **Donnie Jones** over 16 games in 2016).
- **Brandon Graham** (37 years-221 days) became the oldest Eagles defensive player in the Super Bowl Era to appear in a regular-season or postseason game. Graham is the oldest Eagle overall to see action with the team since **Jason Peters** (38 years-319 days) on 12/6/20 at Green Bay.
- Following a sack by **Nolan Smith** on first-and-10 in the second quarter, **Nakobe Dean** registered his first career strip sack and the fumble was recovered by **Jaelan Phillips** at the PHI 35. The takeaway was the 2nd FR of the season for Phillips (also 9/29/25 vs. N.Y. Jets with Miami).
- Philadelphia opened the scoring on its first drive of the second half with a 39-yard FG by **Jake Elliott**, 3-0, completing a 10-play, 55-yard possession. During the series, **Dallas Goedert** caught 3 passes for 35 yards, including a 22-yard reception and an 8-yard third-down conversion.
- The Eagles increased their lead to 10-0 in the fourth quarter with a 36-yard TD pass from **Jalen Hurts** to **DeVonta Smith**, finishing a 4-play, 80-yard drive. Prior to Smith's TD catch, Hurts connected with **Saquon Barkley** on a pass that gained 41 yards on third-and-7.
- **Jaelan Phillips** forced a fumble against Packers RB **Josh Jacobs** in the fourth quarter that was recovered by **Reed Blankenship** at the GB 40 for a crucial stop on fourth-and-1.
- The Eagles held Green Bay to only 7 points, marking their lowest offensive output at home since Detroit (0, 12/30/18).
