

POST-GAME NOTES PHILADELPHIA EAGLES at NEW YORK GIANTS October 9, 2025

POST-GAME NOTES

- Philadelphia jumped out to a 3-0 advantage on its opening drive with a 42-yard FG by Jake Elliott, completing a 6-play, 36-yard possession. During the series, Saquon Barkley (31 yards on 2 carries) rushed for 18 yards (season long) and 13 yards on the first two plays of the game.
 - Barkley eclipsed 10,000+ career scrimmage yards with his 18-yard carry.
- The Eagles cut their deficit to 10-13 in the first quarter with a 3-yard TD to **Dallas Goedert** on a 3-yard TD pass from **Jalen Hurts**, capping a scoring drive that went 75 yards on 8 plays.
 - Goedert has a receiving TD in four consecutive games, tying Zach Ertz (2017) and Charle Young (1974-75) for the longest streak by an Eagles TE since the 1970 NFL merger.
 - Goedert's 5 receiving TDs this season tied a career high (also 2019).
 - Hurts connected on 2 passes of 20+ yards during the possession, featuring a 30yard completion to A.J. Brown along with a 23-yard completion to Goedert.
- Philadelphia reclaimed the lead, 17-13, in the second quarter with a 13-play, 74-yard drive (7:54) that culminated in a 1-yard rushing TD by Jalen Hurts after 4 successive QB sneaks.
 - Hurts leads the Eagles with 5 rushing TDs, ranking 1st among NFL QBs.
 - Hurts completed 4 passes for 10+ yards, including catches for 16 yards (DeVonta Smith), 16 yards (A.J. Brown), and 17 yards (Jahan Dotson) on three straight plays.
